III. OUTREACH INITIATIVES

The following outreach initiatives were completed by the SEU during the reporting period:

A. <u>Management Training</u>:

- 1. The Salem Director of Human Resources conducts monthly HR Network Training sessions via teleconference and Powerpoint presentations, which includes review of EEO policies and compliance. The SEU's Office Manager and Business Manager participate in these training sessions each month and then routinely communicate with the SEU's General Manager and other management team members to keep all employees apprised of the company and SEU's policy on equal employment.
- The SEU participated in the GB Risk Control training for all entry level managers and above to train them in methods of ensuring equal opportunity and preventing discrimination. Training modules include "Ethics in Action", and Sexual Harassment Prevention".
