KRDC(AM) 1110 and K256CX(FM) 99.1 (hereinafter "the Station") - is located in Pasadena, CA. The Station simulcasts ESPN Radio programming from KSPN(AM) 710, Los Angeles. The Station carries programming from the ESPN Radio Network, in addition to live, local programs. Programs include Keyshawn, JWill & Max, hosted by Keyshawn Johnson, Jay Williams and Max Kellerman (airs Monday-Friday, 6:00am-10:00am); Travis & Sliwa Show, hosted by Travis Rodgers and Allen Sliwa (airs Monday-Friday, 10:00am-1:00pm); Mason & Ireland hosted by Steve Mason and John Ireland (airs Monday-Friday, 1:00pm-4:00pm); Sedano & Kap, hosted by Jorge Sedano and Scott Kaplan (airs Monday-Friday, 4:00pm-7:00pm); and Weekend Warrior with Dr. Klapper (airs Saturdays, 7:00am-9:00am). KSPN is also the flagship station of the Los Angeles Lakers, the Los Angeles Rams, the Los Angeles Football Club, and carries various Angels Baseball Games.

Issues of importance to the local community are addressed through a variety of programs. KRDC-AM is a talk station with a special focus on sports. Regular sports programs often include repeated and/or extensive discussions by and among show hosts, guests, and callers of issues of special interest to athletes and sports fans, such as domestic abuse or traumatic brain injuries.

The station also airs a one-hour weekly public affairs show, "Beyond Sports," every Sunday morning. "Beyond Sports," which is broadcast each week from 5:00 to 6:00 AM, is hosted by KRDC-AM Public Affairs Manager, Hannah Stanley. This program often features guests from the local community and from public interest organizations talking about issues of importance to the community which are ascertained by feedback from the community leaders and listeners, and the Station's observations of local media coverage of news and information during that particular quarter. Each week's show focuses on a different issue and features different guests.

To supplement this long-form programming and to further educate listeners about issues of concern to its local community, KRDC-AM airs a wide variety of public service announcements.

Finally, KRDC-AM periodically airs local news briefs and weather reports.
