11/1 – Otay Border Tunnel – TRT: 2:05

Murder charges are filed against the man accused of shooting and killing a TSA agent at Los Angeles International airport. The FBI says Paul Ciancia shot a TSA officer, walked away and then returned down an escalator to shoot him again.
