







EDUCATION ISSUES

3/4/2005 **FOCUS ON SOUTH FLORIDA** Our guests Dr. Alberto Rodriguez from Miami-Dade County Public Schools, Dr. Dino Pedrone from the Fla. Association of Christian Colleges and Schools (FACCS) and Jeannie Floyd from Broward County Schools, Child Development took a look at the new Florida 'universal' or voluntary pre-k program and the slots money for education and reform initiatives.

HEALTH ISSUES

1/7/2005 **FOCUS ON SOUTH FLORIDA** A look at the controversy over fad diets, food and obesity as a health issue and epidemic, along with Health Specialist Dr. Sean Kenniff and Jody Gorran, who is suing the Atkins corporation, claiming that his heart disease is a result of the diet program.

He film follows our second guest Detective Fernando Bosch of the City of Miami Police Department and his team as they search the city for the suspect. Also, discussed is the recent battle over Terry Shiavo and how a new bill set to become a law many not save her life.
