Career Outreach Initiatives/KHSL TV Aug. 1 2010 to July 31, 2011

Internships

KHSL TV continues to offer extensive internship opportunities in cooperation with Chico State, Butte Community College and Shasta Community College. The station internship program is overseen by **News Director**, **Trish Coder**. During this reporting period, the station offered 9 unpaid internships. Interns work at the station between 8 to 12 hours a week.

Job Shadow Program

The KHSL job shadow program promoted participation through various junior high and high school campuses in our market area. During the reporting period, five high school students spend at least one day with a reporter or anchor. The job shadow program allows students to get a first hand feel of what a career in broadcast news requires.
