# FOURTH QUARTER ISSUES PROGRAM LIST FOR TROY UNIVERSITY PUBLIC RADIO October 1 - December 31, 2016 Placed in Public File January 10, 2017

## Section 1. Issues.

The station has identified the following issues as significant issues facing our community this quarter:

- A. Societal Issues: Cochlear Implants to restore hearing loss; how Girl Scouting changed a young life; Montgomery Music Academy for children; Disability Awareness during National Disability Employment Awareness Month; Proposed Constitutional Amendments on State Election Ballot; Wildfires in Alabama and how to protect property; Creek Indian heritage in Alabama; Poet Jacqueline Allen Trimble and how her mother shaped her life journey as an African American; Veterans Day and Troy for Troops; the Syrian refugee crisis; Preserving Oral History through StoryCorps' Great Thanksgiving project; Appalachia poverty and help from Alabama citizens.
- **B. Historical Issues:** the Michael McDowell death collection at Northwestern University; African American Marine Corps General Gary Cooper of Mobile and his war record in Vietnam; Helen Keller's life and legacy; the late Wade Hall's collection of historical postcards; Ed Bridges' new

history book for laypeople about the making of a state; Montgomery County Bicentennial and oral history project in unincorporated communities; Renovating 19th century houses in Montgomery's oldest residential area and rehabilitating the neighborhood; Pearl Harbor Remembrance Day, in the context of honoring the Tomb of the Unknown Soldier and the new film, *The Unknowns*.

C. Alabama Pulitzer Prize Winners and Nominees: A special joint project of Troy Public Radio, the Alabama Writers Forum, and the Alabama Humanities Foundation, presented a five-part radio series recognizing the diverse literary contributions to American life of fifteen Alabama writers. The series was broadcast during the last week of December and was slated for re-broadcast the first week of January 2017.

## **Section II. Responsive Programs**

The station has broadcast programming dealing with each of these issues. Programming on *In Focus* with host Carolyn Hutcheson covered each issue in a 9-minute time frame at 12:40 p.m. during the *Here and Now* news hour. Note: Mondays and Fridays at 12:32 p.m., Don Dailey of Alabama Public Television's *Capitol Journal*, presented a 4-minute recap of the week's political news with the *NewsWrap* and the *Buzzword*. Special correspondent Verna Gates occasionally contributed a *NewsWrap* segment.

## -Broadcast on October 13:

A conversation with Montgomery guest Dot Moore, who gradually lost her hearing as an adult and was helped by surgery with a cochlear implant. She described the process, how she regained her hearing, and told how even infants can receiver cochlear implants to enable them to hear.

#### -Broadcast on October 14:

A conversation with guests daughter Cheyenne and mom Sherry Hayes about how Girl Scouting changed a hild's life. As a six-year-old only child, Cheyenne decided that she wanted to organize a Girl Scout troop at her school and proceeded to do so. Sherry eventually became the troop leader of a multi-age group of girls, and through Scouting Cheyenne developed the self-confidence and commitment to service to become a teen Girl Scout Ambassador.

#### -Broadcast on October 24:

A conversation by Skype with guest Nick Hagelin, a finalist on the TV show, *The Voice*, about his upcoming performance for the Alabama Dance Theater's presentation of *Dracula*. He talked about the challenges of performing on television and on stage before a live audience.

#### -Broadcast on October 24:

A conversation hosted by Montgomery Symphony Conductor Thomas Hinds with guest Kim Wolfe, Executive Director, about the orchestra's new outreach project - the establishment of the Montgomery Academy of Music, to serve young River Region students with music training, which has been previously unavailable.

#### -Broadcast on October 26:

A conversation by Skype with guest Benn Joseph, head of Archival Processing at

Northwestern University in Evanston, Illinois, about the university's collection of Death paraphernalia collected by Enterprise, AL, writer Michael McDowell - Stephen King called him the finest writer of paperback originals in America.

## -Broadcast on October 27:

A conversation with guests Graham Sisson, Assistant Alabama Attorney General and Director of the Governor's Office on Disabilities, and Karl Wade, Disabilities Advocate who serves on several State boards, about Disability Awareness. Sisson became a paraplegic after a drunk driver hit his car, and Wade became blinded by a shotgun blast during a faceoff with a suspect - Wade was leading a tactical team as an Alabama State Trooper at the time. October is Disability Awareness Employment Month.

#### -Broadcast on November 1:

A conversation with guest Don Dailey, News Director for Alabama Public Television and Host of *Capitol Journal*, about the proposed Alabama Constitutional Amendments citizens will vote on during the upcoming election.

### -Broadcast on November 2:

A conversation with guests Dan Jackson, Assistant Alabama State Forester, and John Goff, Director of Forest Operations for the Alabama Forestry Commission, about the acute threat of wildfires because of continuing drought. Both men are wildland firefighters, and they gave tips to landowners on how to protect their property.

#### -Broadcast on November 3:

A conversation with guest Robert Thrower, Poarch Creek Historic Preservation Officer, about his Creek Indian heritage and famous forebears - William Weatherford and Sehoy. He talked about the opportunity for visitors to see 1750s and 1800s French, Indian and frontier military encampments at Frontier Days at Fort Toulouse/Fort Jackson National Historic Site and Park in Wetumpka.

#### -Broadcast on November 8:

A conversation with guest Kendal Weaver, author of a biography (*Ten Stars*) of African American Marine Corps General Gary Cooper of Mobile. Cooper was a trailblazer, whose patriotic service included Vietnam, the Alabama Legislature, Assistant Secretary of the Air Force, and US Ambassador to Jamaica.

#### -Broadcast on November 9:

A conversation with guest Jacqueline Allen Trimble, poet, educator, and author of *American Happiness*, about her journey through American culture as an African American who was heavily influenced by her mother, a foot soldier in the Civil Rights movement and a respected figure in society.

#### -Broadcast on November 10:

A conversation with guest Captain Danielle Pankey, US Army Reserve and Director of the Troy for Troops Center at Troy University, about the center's mission to serve military students, veterans, and their families. A new project is the Veterans Reading Initiative, which will continue in 2017.

#### -Broadcast on November 15:

A conversation with guest David Sorenson, Professor at the Maxwell AFB Air War College, about his experiences as a firsthand observer of the turmoil in Syria and its refugee crisis. He is author of the book, *Syria in Ruins*, and will address the Alabama World Affairs Council at Troy University Montgomery this evening.

#### -Broadcast on November 22:

A conversation with guest Joey Brackner, Folklorist, Host of Alabama Public Television's *Journey Proud*, and Director of the Alabama Center for Traditional Culture, about StoryCorps' Great Thanksgiving Project. Brackner recounted his own experience with recording artists' oral histories, and he encouraged the recording of family oral histories with the Great Thanksgiving Project. He talked about how the process works, with the free StoryCorps app.

#### -Broadcast on November 30:

A conversation with guest Candi Williams, State Director of the AARP, about the toll caregiving takes on the caregiver. She talked about holiday stress and how caregivers can take care of their loved ones while still taking care of themselves. AARP has a caregiving resource section on its website.

#### -Broadcast on December 8:

A conversation by Skype with guest Tim Crawford, a native of west Alabama and Red Bird Mission Director of Development in southeastern Kentucky, about one of the poorest regions in the US, devastated by the loss of 11,000 coal mining jobs. Volunteers from several Alabama communities and churches are making a difference in Appalachia, helping with on-site home repairs and other projects to

assist jobless residents. Some of the residents help support themselves by making mountain handcrafts, which will be presented at the Appalachian Craft Fair at a local Montgomery church Dec. 10.

#### **Historical Issues:**

#### -Broadcast on November 8:

A conversation with guest Kendal Weaver, author of a biography (*Ten Stars*) of African American Marine Corps General Gary Cooper of Mobile. Cooper was a trailblazer, whose patriotic service included Vietnam, the Alabama Legislature, Assistant Secretary of the Air Force, and US Ambassador to Jamaica.

#### -Broadcast on November 14:

A conversation with guest Jeanie Thompson, Poet and Executive Director of the Alabama Writers Forum, about her ten-year research into the life of Alabamian Helen Keller, who became blind and deaf as a toddler. Thompson discussed her findings and the resulting book, *The Myth of Water*. This interview took place in the former Montgomery home of Helen Keller's sister.

#### -Broadcast on November 16:

A conversation with guest Greg Swem, the journalist who accompanied the late writer and educator Wade Hall of Union Springs, AL, and Kentucky on his literary and photographic memorabilia collecting ventures across the US. Hall left his collection of historic color postcards to the Troy University and University of Alabama libraries, and a book, *Greetings from Alabama*, has been published posthumously, featuring the rare postcards.

#### -Broadcast on November 28:

A conversation with guest Ed Bridges, Director Emeritus of the Alabama Department of Archives and History, about stories from his new book, *Alabama*, the Making of a State, a history perspective for laypeople. He shared his favorite stories that were unearthed during his research.

#### -Broadcast on December 1:

A conversation with guests Christy Anderson, Historic Preservationist, and Pastor Gary Burton, President of the Pintlala Historical Association, about Montgomery County's Bicentennial. They talked about how Montgomery County was founded and how three county historical groups will celebrate the Bicentennial in 2017 with oral history projects involving the county's unincorporated communities.

## -Broadcast on December 6:

A conversation with guests Heather Logan, Cottage Hill Foundation Board member, and Johnny Veres, President, about renovating their homes in Montgomery's oldest residential area. They talked about their homes' unusual features and the Foundation's efforts to cultivate a diverse and revitalized neighborhood. A Candlelight Tour will highlight the progress that's been made on rehabilitating more than a dozen 19th century structures.

### -Broadcast on December 8:

A conversation with guests Ethan Morse, Producer, and Neil Schrodetzki, Director, members of the Society of the Honor Guard for the Tomb of the Unknown Soldier, about their documentary film, *The Unknowns*, the story of guarding the Tomb of the Unknown Soldier. They discussed their journey from Fort Benning, GA, to Arlington, VA, the training and rigorous requirements of the Honor Guard, and how the Unknown Soldier was chosen. The US Army sponsored their film. During the interview, the guests acknowledged Pearl Harbor Day and those who gave their lives in WWII.
