Section I. Issues.

The station has identified the following issues as significant issues facing our community this quarter:

- A. Environmental Issues:** Nineteenth century naturalist Phillip Henry Gosse, who collected insect specimens in 1838 in Dallas County, Alabama; Urban Forestry; Alabama Tree Recovery Campaign; Forever Wild history timeline;
- B. Societal Issues:** Children with Diabetes; Domestic Violence Awareness Month; Americans with Disabilities Act; Elder Abuse; Higher Education and Workforce Development; the Literary Arts and At-risk Children; the Rosa Parks' 100th Birthday Wishes Project with school children; the Middle East; U.S. Military Deaths in all wars; Veterans Day Special: *Every Voice Counts*; the Arab Spring and Islamic-Western political relationships; Compassionate Friends (help for bereaved families); Social Security update; Year-end Tax Planning; Nutritional Health; Living with Cancer; Tai Chi and Wellness.
- C. Historical Issues:** Public access to archaeological sites; 19th Century skills of Alabamians; the Literary legacy of F. Scott and Zelda Fitzgerald; the Creek Indian War of 1813-14; Alabama Frontier History in the 1750s; Elisabeth von Trapp; Alabama Department of Archives and History; the War of 1812 and its impact on Alabama;

Section II: Responsive Programs.

The station has broadcast programming dealing with each of the above-referenced issues. Programming on *Community Focus*, with host Carolyn Hutcheson, dealt with each issues in a 14-minute time frame, beginning at 12:10 p.m. Central time, each weekday.

A. Environmental Issues:

-Broadcast on Oct. 11:

A discussion with guests Gary Mullen, Professor Emeritus of Entomology, and Taylor Littleton, Professor Emeritus of Science and Humanities, both at Auburn, about 19th century English naturalist Phillip Henry Gosse, who taught school in Dallas County, Alabama in 1838 and collected entomological specimens. He later published his watercolor illustrations of insect and marine organisms. Gosse's *Letters from Alabama* chronicled his time spent in a frontier culture.

-Broadcast on Oct. 29:

A discussion with guest Russell Stringer, Urban Forester for the City of Montgomery, about the historical development of the capital city's urban forest. He previewed the Nov. 1 presentation of "Trees for Prairie Soil," open to the public and hosted by the nonprofit Take Roots Montgomery at the Alabama Forestry Commission.

-Broadcast on Nov. 1:

A discussion with guest Matt McCullough, State Urban Forestry Coordinator with the Alabama Forestry Commission, about the Alabama Tree Recovery Campaign, an ongoing project to replant trees in areas destroyed by the April 2011 tornadoes. He kicks off Tree Planting Month and gives advice on how to properly plant a tree.

-Broadcast on Nov. 2:

A discussion with guest Dr. Doug Phillips, Outdoor Educator and Host of Alabama Public Television's *Discovering Alabama*, about the history of the establishment of the Forever Wild Land Trust, which acquires land for public use and preservation, without the use of tax dollars. Administered by the Alabama Department of Conservation and Natural Resources, Forever Wild will be voted on for renewal by the voters in November.

B. Societal & Health Issues:

-Broadcast on Oct. 5:

A discussion with guests Durden Dean, Chairman of the River Region Lions Clubs Children's Diabetic Camp Committee, and Cindy Ducker, President of the Prattville Lions Club, about Camp Sugar Falls, a free day camp for diabetic children and their families on Oct. 21 at the Alabama Nature Center. The camp is held in conjunction with the Southeastern Diabetes organization.

-Broadcast on Oct. 9:

A discussion about Domestic Violence Awareness Month, with guest Sara DuBose, award-winning writer, who tackled the subject in a novel, *Uncharted Waters*, set in Montgomery, with a main character based on the actual police lieutenant who headed up the city's domestic violence unit.

-Broadcast on Oct. 24:

A discussion with guest Graham Sisson, Executive Director of the Alabama Governor's Office on Disabilities and State ADA Coordinator, about the Americans with Disabilities Act and how it is implemented.

-Broadcast on Oct. 25:

A discussion with guests Dr. John Bitter and Bill Richards, members of the Alabama Silver Haired Legislature, about the issue of Elder Abuse. Alabama has a new law defining Elder Abuse, and two organizations are active in increasing public awareness – the Alabama Council for Prevention of Elder Abuse and the Elder Justice Alliance.

-Broadcast on Oct. 26:

A discussion with guest Jeff Coleman, Chairman of the Alabama Commission on Higher Education, about the goal to make Alabama an educated state - the key factor in a successful workforce. He talked about the total education experience, from pre-kindergarten through higher education, as essential to the economic future of Alabama.

-Broadcast on Oct. 30:

A discussion with guest Jeanie Thompson, Executive Director of the Alabama Writers' Forum, a partner of the State Arts Council, about the role of the Forum in developing the Literary Arts in the state. She gave an update on the ongoing writing project at the Mount Meigs Youth Facility and shared several selections from their latest book.

-Broadcast on Nov. 7:

A discussion with guest Georgette Norman, Director of the Troy University Rosa Parks Museum, about the Rosa Parks 100th Birthday Wishes Project Nov. 10. The project collects Rosa Parks birthday wishes from school children everywhere and reflects their wishes for society today. Georgette shared a number of their wishes – for world peace, equality, compassion, no school bullying, etc.

-Broadcast on Nov. 8:

A discussion with guests Dr. James Nathan, Executive Director of the Alabama World Affairs Council, and the Honorable Edmund Hull, U.S. Ambassador to Yemen 2001-2004 and an AWAC speaker, about the recent death of U.S. Ambassador Chris Stevens in Libya. Ambassador Hull, who survived an assassination attempt, talked about the challenges to ambassadors to be prepared to do whatever it takes to serve U.S. interests, despite personal danger. The guests discussed the Middle East and Yemen's strategic importance to the U.S.

-Broadcast on Nov. 9:

In a preview of Veterans Day, a discussion with guest Lt. Col. Bill Stewart (USAF Ret.), about the number of U.S. Military deaths in all wars. He shared his often-requested original composition, *I Am Your Flag*, originally presented to the Exchange Clubs of North America in 2002, as well as to the Alabama Legislature. Lt. Col. Stewart presents the talk to other groups upon request.

-Broadcast on Nov. 12:

A Veterans Day Special: *Every Voice Counts*, a discussion with guests David Dyson about the earliest observance of National Veterans Day in Birmingham, as originated by Raymond Meeks and President Eisenhower; Retired Col. Albert Killian (from a pre-recorded on-location interview in Opelika) about POW Camp Opelika in WWII; the late Lt. Col. Herbert Carter, an original Tuskegee Airman (from an earlier phone interview); and Sylvie Lubow (by phone) about the Military Voices Initiative of StoryCorps.

-Broadcast on Nov. 20:

A discussion with guests Dr. James Nathan, Executive Director of the Alabama World Affairs Council, and by phone from the University of Denver Dr. Nader Hashemi, Director of the Center for Middle East Studies at the Josef Korbel School of International Studies, about the Arab Spring, Islamic-Western political relationships, and the U.S. outlook for dealing with terrorists. Dr. Hashemi's family is from Iran, but as a pro-Democracy activist, he is unable to visit them. He is scheduled to address the AWAC Nov. 27.

-Broadcast on Dec. 3:

A discussion with guest Karen Story of the Montgomery Chapter of Compassionate Friends about the organization's mission to support grieving families whose children have died. There is a Worldwide Candle Lighting Ceremony of Remembrance on Dec. 9.

-Broadcast on Dec. 4:

A discussion with guest Kyle' McKinney, Social Security Public Affairs Specialist, about the 1.7% Cost of Living Adjustment for 2013, Open Enrollment for Medicare Part D, Mandatory Direct Deposit for Social Security recipients by March 2013, and Identity Theft prevention over the holidays.

-Broadcast on Dec. 12:

A discussion with guests Adam Causey, Montgomery Certified Public Accountant, and Diane Christy, Vice-President of Communications for the Alabama Society of Certified Public Accountants, about year-end tax planning for individuals and businesses. Adam Causey also addressed the "Fiscal Cliff" scenario, as well as ramifications of the Patient Protection and Affordable Care Act.

-Broadcast on Dec. 17:

A discussion with guest Mim Gaines, MACT, RD, LD, and Nutrition and Physical Activity Director for the Alabama Department of Public Health, about Healthy Tips for Holiday Eating. Small changes to recipes can add up to holidays without weight gain. Alabama continues to be in the top tier of states grappling with obesity and its related diseases.

-Broadcast on Dec. 20:

An on-location (Valley Grande City Park) discussion about cancer with guest Dr. David Schell, Licensed Professional Counselor/Marriage and Family Therapist and Stage IV cancer patient, who has outlived his prognosis. As a patient, a psychotherapist, and a former caregiver, Dr. Schell talked about a wide range of issues faced by cancer patients and their families. He shared his advice about coping with chronic illness, depression, the holidays, and finding a renewed sense of purpose in life. He wrote *Holy Cow I Have Cancer! Now What?* to help others with their cancer journey or chronic illness.

-Broadcast on Dec. 28:

A discussion with guests Bob Varley and Janet Hutto, Tai Chi Instructors with the Taoist Tai Chi Society of the USA, Alabama Branch, about research into the health attributes of Tai Chi, as well as its history in ancient China. Tai Chi classes across our coverage area start in the New Year.

C. Historical Issues:

-Broadcast on Oct. 1:

A discussion with guest Teresa Paglione, President of the Alabama Archaeological Society, about Archaeology Month. National Archaeology Day is Oct. 20, and she talked about special events planned across the state to familiarize Alabamians with archeological sites and the concurrent history they represent.

Broadcast on Oct. 2:

A discussion with guest Jimmy Harris, Director of the Alabama Nature Center at Lanark in Millbrook, about the Good Ole Days event Oct. 20. He talked about activities that demonstrate the skills used by those who worked the land – quilting, herding dogs and demonstrations, flint knapping, cornmeal grinding, woodcarving, bee keeping and goat cheese making.

-Broadcast on Oct. 4:

A discussion with guest Willie Thompson, Executive Director of the Scott and Zelda Fitzgerald Museum, about the internationally known couple known as the “Darlings of the Jazz Age,” their Alabama connection, and their legacy in the Arts.

-Broadcast on Oct. 22:

An on-location discussion at Fort Toulouse-Fort Jackson National Historic Landmark, recorded Labor Day weekend, with guests Jim Parker, Historical Archaeologist and Site Director of the park operated by the Alabama Historical Commission, and Leh (Lee) Lehman, Re-enactor from Ariton, Alabama, about the Creek Indian War of 1813-14, Andrew Jackson, and the role Fort Jackson played in the birth of Alabama as a state. Fort Jackson Living History Weekend encampments are held the first weekend of each month, and the guests also previewed Frontier Days Nov. 7-11 at the site.

-Broadcast on Nov. 5:

An on-location discussion at Fort Toulouse, recorded September 15, with guests Ned Jenkins, Park Archaeologist, and Re-enactors Richard Cumbie, Anna Fleming, Donna Spradley, Charles Simon and Ken Branson about domestic and military life in the 1750s at the French Colonial Fort Toulouse, at the confluence of the Coosa and Tallapoosa rivers. The French cannon was fired for the crowd, in a preview of Frontier Days Nov. 7-11 at the site.

-Broadcast on Nov. 16:

A discussion by phone by Kyle Gassiott with guest Elisabeth von Trapp, whose family inspired the movie, *The Sound of Music*. Born and raised in Vermont, Elisabeth is the granddaughter of Maria and Baron von Trapp. She shared her family story, and she continues their musical tradition in her professional career as a vocalist. On Dec. 1, she is scheduled to perform at the Troy University Davis Theatre with the Empire Brass in "The Sound of Christmas."

-Broadcast on Nov. 21:

A discussion with guest Dr. Ed Bridges, Director Emeritus of the Alabama Department of Archives and History, about this oldest state Archives agency in the nation and its plans to complete the new Museum of Alabama, which will tell the story of the state.

-Broadcast on Nov. 28:

A discussion with guest Mike Bunn, Executive Director of the Historic Chattahoochee Commission and co-author of the *Battle for the Southern Frontier*, about the impact of the War of 1812 and the Creek Indian War of 1813-14 on the Southeast. He talked about significant battle sites in our coverage area.
