

**FIRST QUARTER ISSUES PROGRAMS LIST FOR
TROY UNIVERSITY PUBLIC RADIO
January 1 – March 31, 2016
Placed in the Public File April 7, 2016**

Section I. Issues.

The station has identified the following issues as significant issues facing our community this quarter:

- A. Environmental Issues:** Planting Trees to Attract Wildlife; Prattville's Wilderness Park Bamboo Forest.
- B. Societal Issues:** The Presidential Race from the perspective of a musician; Lions International's commitment to service across the globe; Concerts for a cause; US-Cuba Relations; Brussels terrorist bombings.
- C. Historical Issues:** Investigating Cold Cases from the Civil Rights Era; Alabama Historic Places in Peril; the Three Wives of Booker T. Washington, founder of Tuskegee University; the Legacy of Harper Lee; the Moonshine Era; the evolving portrayal of African American women by Jet magazine in the 50s and 60s.

Note: Each Monday guest Don Dailey, Host-Producer of Capitol Journal on Alabama Public Television, recorded a four-minute recap of the political happenings in Alabama state government, to keep the listeners informed about legislative efforts to draft a state budget. On Thursdays, award-winning Birmingham reporter Verna Gates alternated with Don Dailey to record a wrap up of the week's key events in Alabama news.

Section II: Responsive Programs

Broadcasts by the station dealt with programming on each of the above-referenced issues. Programming on *In Focus*, with host Carolyn Hutcheson, targeted each issue within a 6-minute time frame, between 12:40 and 1:00 p.m. weekdays.

A. Environmental Issues:

-Broadcast on Feb. 16:

A discussion by phone from Valparaiso, Florida, with guest Marie Harrison, gardening author and horticulture instructor for the National Federation of Garden Clubs, about planting trees to attract wildlife. She talked about the correct way to plant trees, to ensure their survival.

-Broadcast on Feb. 26:

An on-location discussion in Prattville with guests Kellie Cook, Parks and Recreation Director, and Devin Peek, Superintendent of Urban Management, about Alabama's unique forest of giant bamboo trees in Wilderness Park. The urban forest originally was used as a troop survival training area, but was preserved by the city for public enjoyment.

B. Societal & Health Issues:

-Broadcast on March 2:

A discussion with guest Marcus Roberts, renowned jazz pianist, who delivered the Helen Keller Lecture at Troy University. Roberts, blind since the age of five, used his musician's ear to compose theme music that reflected the presidential candidates' tempo.

-Broadcast on March 3:

A discussion with guest Bob Corlew on the Lions International Tour Bus. Corlew is the incoming international president of the world's largest service organization and talked about the range of projects being carried out all over the world. Helen Keller in 1925 charged Lions clubs to become Knights of the Blind, so projects include sight screenings and preservation, diabetes awareness (diabetes is a cause of blindness), measles remediation, and environmental programs (over 3 million trees have been planted worldwide).

-Broadcast on March 9:

A discussion by phone with guest Michael Gabriel, guitarist and composer who travels across Canada and the US to play concerts with local groups to benefit a cause. He was scheduled to perform in Enterprise with Con Amore string quartet and the Tri-Community Orchestra as a benefit for the SOS Animal Adoption Center. Gabriel likes to use his music to bring communities together in service.

-Broadcast on March 16:

A discussion with guest Phillip Brenner, considered to be the country's foremost scholar of the Cuban Revolution, and James Nathan, executive director of the Alabama World Affairs Council, about US-Cuba relations prior to President Obama's current visit. Brenner had dinners with Fidel Castro and frequently teaches in Cuba, so he talked about the Castro he knew as a revolutionary who initially distrusted the Russians. Brenner is a senior professor at American University.

Note: On March 24, during a segment of *All Things Considered*, Brenner did a follow-up interview about the future of US-Cuba relations after President Obama's visit.

-Broadcast on March 23:

A discussion with guest Major General Walter D. Givhan (USAF Ret.) about the current terrorist attacks in Brussels, Belgium. Givhan served in US State Department as Assistant Deputy Secretary in charge of US Global Assistance. Currently he serves as Troy University Senior Vice Chancellor for Advancement and Economic Development. Givhan talked about what it will take to combat the continuing threat of terrorism.

C. Historical Issues:

Broadcast on Feb. 16:

A discussion by phone with guest Hank Klibanoff, journalist and co-author of the Pulitzer Prize winning book, *The Race Beat: The Press, The Civil Rights Struggle, and The Awakening of a Nation*, about the Georgia Civil Rights Cold Cases Project he oversees at Emory University, where he teaches.

-Broadcast on Feb. 18:

A discussion with guest Michael Panhorst, architectural historian, about Places in Peril, a statewide program to identify historic properties at risk. Panhorst coordinates the program that endeavors to preserve buildings and structures that figure in Alabama's history. Nominations are accepted at www.alabamatrust.info.

-Broadcast on Feb. 25:

A discussion with guest Dyann Robinson, founder/director of the Tuskegee Repertory Theatre, about her play, *The Three Wives of Booker T.* Robinson researched Booker T. Washington's family to unearth the story of his three wives and the pivotal role each played in the founding of Tuskegee University. A driven man, Washington depended on his wives to implement many of his plans to develop the educational institution for African American students. His first two wives died within five years of each other, but the third survived him.

-Broadcast on Feb. 26:

A discussion with guest Kirk Curnutt, professor of English at Troy University and co-host of the program, "He Read, She Read," about the legacy of Alabama author Harper Lee. Curnutt talked about Lee's literary restraint in publishing only two books – the landmark *To Kill a Mockingbird* and its prequel or sequel, *Go Set a Watchman*.

-Broadcast on March 3:

A discussion with guest Elyzabeth Gregory Wilder, Playwright-in Residence at the University of the South – Sewanee, TN, and author of the Alabama Shakespeare Festival play, *White Lightning*, about her research into the history of moonshine and its role in the birth of NASCAR. Wilder interviewed former moonshiners and revenue agents in Dawsonville, GA, at moonshiner reunions.

-Broadcast on March 17:

A discussion with guest Felecia Bell, director of the Troy University Rosa Parks Museum, about the recent acquisition of some 500 African American magazines contributed by an anonymous donor. Bell talked about the evolving portrayal of African American women on the covers of Jet magazine in the 50s and 60s. Prominent women were initially portrayed as pretty and family-centered. Later they were portrayed as civil rights activists.
