

**THIRD QUARTER ISSUES PROGRAMS LIST FOR
TROY UNIVERSITY PUBLIC RADIO**

Section I. Issues.

The station has identified the following issues as significant topics facing our community this quarter:

- A. Environmental Issues:** Geotourism; Wildland Firefighting; Renewable Energy; Alabama Water Policy; Hummingbird Science; Charles Darwin's Theory of Evolution; Alabama's Pinhoti Trail; Hurricane Katrina Anniversary; Modern Agriculture; Old Cahawba Archaeological Park; the Artistic Interpretation of Costa Rica's Flora and Fauna.
- B. Societal Issues:** Securities Investment and Financial Literacy; Consumer Issues; Early Childhood Education; Dog and Cat Overpopulation; Heat Sickness and Heat Stroke; Adult Literacy; Village Networks for Seniors; Kenya Relief efforts; Crimestoppers; Families in Crisis; Interpreter Training; The Congo; Urban Land Use Planning; Health Recovery using Tai Chi; Genetic Engineering; the Farm to Table Movement; Lifelong Learning; Diplomacy in Solving International Crises.
- C. Historical Issues:** President Franklin D. Roosevelt's Little White House Historic Site; F. Scott and Zelda Fitzgerald; Alabama Governor's Mansion; Alabama Voices, the story of Alabama from 1700 to 2000; Frank Lloyd Wright House in Florence, AL; Archaeological findings at Horseshoe Bend National Military Park; The Fort Mims Massacre; Integration of Tuskegee High School in 1963 (two-part interview); Post-Civil War Forced Labor of African Americans; Launch of the Creek Heritage Trail; Creek Indian Wars of 1813-14; 50th Anniversary of Dr. Martin Luther King's *I Have a Dream* Speech; the last photograph of FDR; Labor Day remembrance of Opelika's Pepperell Mill Village; Medieval Spain; Mystery of Captain Meriwether Lewis' Death on the Natchez Trace; Former First Lady of Costa Rica and the Path to Costa Rican Democracy; Post-Civil War Emigration of African Americans from the Chattahoochee Valley to Liberia; the Berlin Airlift of 1948-49; Shawnee Chief Tecumseh at Tuckabatchee.

Section II: Responsive Programs.

The station has broadcast programming dealing with each of the above-referenced issues. Programming on *Community Focus*, with host Carolyn Hutcheson, dealt with each issue in a 15-minute time frame, beginning at 12:10 p.m. Central time, each weekday. In mid-September, the programs were reduced to a 12-minute time frame.

A. Environmental Issues:

-Broadcast on July 1:

A discussion with guest Ike Lyon, Site/Resource Manager for the Alabama River Lakes, U.S. Army Corps of Engineers, about the new Geo-Tourism National Geographic Gulf States Program for Alabama, Florida, Louisiana and Mississippi. Longleaf Alliance, at the Solon Dixon Forestry Center in Andalusia. He described the flora and fauna of the Longleaf Pine ecosystem and efforts to restore the Longleaf Pine to its native habitat in our coverage area.

-Broadcast on July 24:

A discussion with guests John Rogers, Co-Manager of Energy and Water in a Warming World (EW3), and Dr. Sandra Sattler, Combustion Scientist and Energy Modeler in the Climate and Energy Program, the Union of Concerned Scientists, about the aging energy power infrastructure and the feasibility of energy diversification.

-Broadcast on July 26:

A discussion with Alabama Forestry Commission guests John Goff, Assistant Director, Forest Operations Division, and Balsie Butler, Fire Operations Chief, about the fighting Western wildfires. They talked about the dangers of wildland firefighting and the establishment of the Yarnell, Arizona, Fallen Firefighters Fund, following the death of 19 Hot Shot firefighters on Granite Mountain. A subsequent program on wildland firefighting in the Pacific Northwest was broadcast on Sept. 10 with guests from the AFC – Task Force Leaders Jason Berry and Joel Bartlett, about the skills required to fight fire in difficult terrain.

-Broadcast on July 31:

A discussion with guest Adam Johnston, Alliance Coordinator for the nonprofit Alabama Rivers Alliance, about statewide efforts to gather stakeholder input, toward developing a comprehensive water management plan for Alabama. One of the stakeholder meetings is scheduled for Aug.8 at Troy University Dothan.

-Broadcast on Aug. 9

A discussion with guest Fred Bassett, Federally licensed Master Bird Bander with the nonprofit Hummingbird Research Group, about his summer banding of hummingbirds in Alaska, where he banded 440 Rufous hummingbirds on islands along the Inland Passage. On Sept. 30, a pre-recorded program was broadcast, featuring Fred banding a Ruby-throated hummingbird in his yard. He explained the step-by-step process.

-Broadcast on Aug. 16:

A discussion with guests Dr. James Bradley, W. Kelly Moseley Professor Emeritus of Biology at Auburn University, and Jay Lamar, Director of Special Programs, Office of the Assistant Provost for Undergraduate Studies at Auburn, about Darwin's famous Theory of Evolution. The guests are co-editors of

Darwin, A Celebration of His Life and Legacy.

-Broadcast on Aug. 27:

A discussion with guest McDowell Crook, Montgomery attorney and veteran hiker, about Alabama's Pinhoti Trail, a side extension of the famed Appalachian Trail. Slated to become part of the Eastern Continental Trail, stretching from Canada through Alabama, the Pinhoti currently ends at Flag Mountain in Coosa County.

-Broadcast on Aug. 29:

A discussion with guests: award-winning journalist and Mississippi Coast native Kathleen Koch (by phone from Maryland) and Mississippi coast relief volunteer John Benton of Prattville (in studio) about the eighth anniversary of Hurricane Katrina and the remaining obstacles to Gulf coast recovery. Kathleen has initiated a project to bring mayors from communities impacted by Katrina together with mayors of communities affected by Hurricane Sandy, to share their knowledge.

-Broadcast on Sept. 19:

A discussion with guests Dr. Lisa Kriese-Anderson, Animal Scientist at Auburn University, and Maggie Lawrence, Alabama Cooperative Extension System, about Ag Discovery Adventure Day Sept. 28 at the E.V. Smith Research Center. The comprehensive one-day event introduces children and their families to modern agricultural methods.

-Broadcast on Sept. 24:

A discussion recorded at the Alabama Historical Commission's Old Cahawba Archaeological Park outside Selma, with guests Linda Derry, Site Director and archaeologist, Jonathan Mathews, Assistant Director, and Alabama Department of Conservation and Natural Resources staff Kim Nix, Editor of *Outdoor Alabama* magazine, Kenny Johnson, Public Information Specialist, and Chris Smith, State Lands Manager, about Old Cahawba's ecological and historical significance and its link to the adjoining Forever Wild tract.

-Broadcast on Sept. 25:

A discussion with guest artist Emily Gassenheimer, who left Montgomery twenty-five years ago to pursue her artistic interpretation of Costa Rica's flora and fauna. She talked about the importance of howler monkeys, snakes, and insects of the jungle and how she has used these themes in her paintings, ceramics, and sculpture.

B. Societal & Health Issues:

-Broadcast on July2:

A discussion with guest Dan Lord, Education and Public Affairs Manager for the

Alabama Securities Commission, about strategies for smarter investing. Financial literacy is a priority of the Commission, in educating consumers and high school students.

-Broadcast on July 3:

A discussion with guest David Smitherman, President and CEO of the Better Business Bureau of Central Alabama and the Wiregrass, with advice on avoiding travel scams during the summer. The BBB maintains an extensive database on businesses and charities.

-Broadcast on July 10:

A discussion by telephone with guest Glenda Davis, educator and Board member of the first Dothan Montessori school. She talked about the Montessori method of early childhood education.

-Broadcast on July 11:

A discussion with Dr. Rachel Tears, Alabama Animal Alliance President and Executive Director, about the overpopulation of dogs and cats in Alabama. The Alabama Animal Alliance provides spay/neuter services, in its mission to reduce the number of abandoned and homeless pets and euthanized animals in shelters.

-Broadcast on July 12:

A discussion with guests Miriam Gaines, Nutrition and Physical Activity Director for the Alabama Department of Public Health, and Sonny Dill, ADPH Intern, about the prevention of heat sickness and heat stroke. Sonny was a victim of heat stroke as a young athlete. The guests talk about hydration effectiveness.

-Broadcast on July 17:

A discussion with guest Katie Jackson, Board member of the Lee County Literacy Coalition, about the efforts to help adults learn to read. The Great Grown-Up Spelling Bee on July 25 raises funds to buy lesson supplies for this United Way agency.

-Broadcast on July 18:

A discussion with guests Joanna Hoit, President of Village Friends/Village Values, and Jim Disque, VFVV subscriber and volunteer, about the 'village' concept of aging in place, with Seniors living in their homes and enjoying a community support system. There are 120 nonprofit villages across the U.S. and internationally in the Village to Village Network. A new one is in east Alabama.

-Broadcast on Aug. 1:

A discussion with guest Henrietta MacGuire about her journey to Kenya with members of her family, to document relief efforts through the nonprofit Kenya Relief organization.

-Broadcast on Aug. 6:

A discussion with guests Susan Moss, Executive Director, and Tony Garrett, Community Outreach Coordinator, about Central Alabama Crimestoppers' efforts to bring criminals to justice. The organization also has been working with schools and businesses on crime prevention.

-Broadcast on Aug. 8:

A discussion with guest Will O'Rear, former Family Court Judge, Licensed Mental Health Counselor and Montgomery attorney, and Director of Samaritan Family Mediation Services for the nonprofit Samaritan Counseling Center, about families in crisis, battered spouse syndrome, domestic violence, and getting help from the One Place Family Justice Center.

-Broadcast on Aug. 20:

A discussion with guest Judy Robertson of Luverne, Lecturer for the Troy University Interpreter Training Program, about the pressing need for interpreters. She grew up in a household with parents who were deaf. Judy talked about American Sign Language and the Americans with Disabilities Act and gave resource information for families with deaf and hard of hearing children.

-Broadcast on Aug. 22:

A discussion by phone with guest Faith Eidse of Tallahassee, FL, Adjunct Professor of English at Barry University, about her childhood in the Congo, where her mother, a nurse, was successful in administering a cure for leprosy, and her father served as a minister and linguist. Faith, who edited her parents' memoir, talked about narrowly escaping attack by rebels during the Simba Revolution.

-Broadcast on Aug. 26:

A discussion with guest Justin Steinmann, Principal Planner for the City of Auburn, about how the citizens of Auburn have helped shape their downtown. He gave an update on the award-winning Comp 2030 comprehensive land use plan for the City and talked about how the personality of a city is its downtown.

-Broadcast on Sept. 3:

A discussion with guest Janet Hutto, Tai Chi Instructor, about the newest initiative of the Taoist Tai Chi Society's Alabama Chapter – a Health Recovery Class, to help people regain their health following illness, accident or surgery.

-Broadcast on Sept. 4:

A discussion with guest Dr. James Bradley, Professor Emeritus in Biological Sciences at Auburn University, about the science and ethics of genetic manipulation and the applied uses. His book, *Brutes or Angels, Human Possibility in the Age of Biotechnology*, explores the science.

-Broadcast on Sept. 5:

A discussion by phone with guest William Holman, Executive Director of

Landmark Park in Dothan, about the popular Farm to Table movement, its roots in our agricultural heritage, and the new farming techniques being used at the park. Landmark Park, site of Alabama's Agricultural Museum, will host two Farm to Table events this fall.

-Broadcast on Sept. 6:

A discussion with guests Carl Thompson, Board member and instructor for the Osher Lifelong Learning Institute (OLLI) at Auburn University, and Susan Stanley, OLLI Membership Chair, about the opportunities offered by this lifelong learning institute to help maintain cognitive brain health and social interaction through its multitude of courses and activities.

-Broadcast on Sept. 20:

A discussion with guest Dr. James Nathan, Executive Director of the Alabama World Affairs Council and former U.S. Foreign Service Officer, about the use of diplomacy in solving world crises. He addressed the topic of Syria and the Middle East, and he previewed the roster of international speakers coming to the Alabama World Affairs Council. Membership is open to the public.

C. Historical Issues:

-Broadcast on July 5:

A rebroadcast of a visit by Kyle Gassiott to FDR's Little White House in Warm Springs, GA, on a tour with the site historian about FDR's home, the Little White House Museum, and his death at the beloved retreat in 1945.

Broadcast on July 8:

A discussion with guest Dr. Kirk Curnutt, Vice-President of the F. Scott Fitzgerald Society and the Scott and Zelda Fitzgerald Museum, and Chair of the English Department at Troy University Montgomery, about the 12th Annual Fitzgerald Conference Nov. 6-10 at the Troy Montgomery campus.

-Broadcast on July 16:

A discussion with guests, Alabama First Lady Dianne Benton; Karen Benton, Acquisitions Chair and Board member of the Friends of the Alabama Governor's Mansion; and Carole King, Historic Preservationist and Board member of the Friends group, about the status of preservation efforts of the Alabama Governor's Mansion.

-Broadcast on July 23:

A discussion with guests Debbie Pendleton, Assistant Director for Public Services at the Alabama Department of Archives and History, and Georgia Ann Conner, Communications Officer, of the centerpiece of the new Museum of Alabama – Alabama Voices, the story of Alabama from 1700 to 2000.

-Broadcast on July 30:

An on-location discussion in Florence, AL, with guest architect Bob Whitten, about the Rosenbaum House, the only structure in Alabama designed by Frank Lloyd Wright. Bob Whitten talked about the innovations Wright designed, while integrating buildings with the surrounding environment.

-Broadcast on Aug. 7:

A discussion by phone from Horseshoe Bend National Military Park with guest National Park Service archaeologist John Cornelison, with the Southeast Archaeological Center in Tallahassee, FL, about locating the actual Barricade that separated Red Stick Creek Indians from Andrew Jackson's forces in 1814 at the Battle of Horseshoe Bend. The Creek Barricade was recently located, using ground penetrating radar and other equipment.

-Broadcast on Aug. 12:

A discussion with guests Dr. Mark Wilson, Director of the Caroline Marshall Draughon Center for the Arts & Humanities at Auburn University; Willie B. Wyatt, Jr., of Stone Mountain, GA, and one of the original thirteen students who integrated Tuskegee High School in 1963; Judge Pete Johnson of Birmingham, who would have been a classmate of Willie Wyatt; and Andy Hornsby, former Alabama Deputy State Finance Director, whose father was Sheriff of Macon County in 1963, about the events surrounding the integration of Tuskegee High School. A Symposium was planned for Aug. 23-24 in Tuskegee. Part II of the Interview, dealing with attempts to integrate Notasulga High School, also in Macon County, was broadcast Aug. 22.

-Broadcast on Aug. 13:

A discussion with guests Lavonda Gosselin, Coordinator of the Evergreen Center for Dialogue and Discernment in Dothan, and Chris McCauley, Director of Operations for the David Mathews Center for Civic Life, about "Injustice Remembered," a community-based event Aug. 27 at Troy University Dothan. The guests talked about the topic of forced labor of African Americans after the Civil War, in both northern and southern states. The PBS film, *Slavery By Another Name* highlighted the story.

-Broadcast on Aug. 14:

A discussion with guest Mike Bunn, historian and Executive Director of the Historic Chattahoochee Commission, about the launch of the Creek Heritage Trail, with the completion of the first two outdoor interpretive centers in Eufaula, AL, and Bainbridge, GA. A dozen planned stops in both states will illustrate the story of Creek Indian heritage and removal.

-Broadcast on Aug. 15:

A discussion with guest Sharman Burson Ramsey of Dothan about her family

genealogy – she is related to Cherokee Chief James Vann, and how that family history led to her writing a historical novel, *Swimming with Serpents*, about the Creek Indian Wars of 1813-14.

-Broadcast on Aug. 19:

A discussion with guest Georgia Ann Conner, a native of Baldwin County and a Re-enactor and Board member of the Fort Mims Restoration Association, about the Fort Mims Massacre, its 200th Anniversary Re-enactment Aug. 30-Sept. 1, and the Living History Encampment at the Fort site.

-Broadcast on Aug. 28:

An on-location visit with guest Althea Thompson Thomas at her music studio about her appointment by Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr., to be church organist at Dexter Avenue King Memorial Baptist Church. Mrs. Thomas reminisced about the years that she knew Dr. and Mrs. King and the family and talked about what he meant to his church and the nation.

-Broadcast on Aug. 30:

A discussion by phone with guest historian Brian Roslund, President of the Friends of the Franklin D. Roosevelt Little White House in Warm Springs, GA, about the last known photograph taken of President Roosevelt, two hours before his death in 1945.

-Broadcast on Sept. 2 - Labor Day:

A discussion by phone with guest Jane Worthington about her experiences growing up in Opelika's Pepperell Mill Village, where her parents worked in the textile mill. The historic mill burned on March 12, 2013, but the "Pepperell Kids" plan to build a monument, and they hope for a historic marker.

-Broadcast on Sept. 9:

A discussion by phone with Dr. John Cressler, Engineering Professor at Georgia Tech and historical novelist, about the era of political and religious tolerance in Medieval Spain. He will talk about that era in a lecture on Sept. 16 at Troy University Dothan and share excerpts from his book, *Emeralds of the Alhambra*.

-Broadcast on Sept. 11:

A discussion by phone with guest independent historian Kira Gale of Omaha, Nebraska, about the circumstances of the death of Meriwether Lewis of Lewis and Clark fame. From ten years of research, Kira concludes that he was murdered on the Natchez Trace, and the family favors exhumation of the body for evidence. Her evidence is contained in the book, *The Death of Meriwether Lewis, A Historic Crime Scene Investigation*.

-Broadcast on Sept. 12:

A discussion in studio with guest Henrietta Boggs Figueres, former First Lady of

Costa Rica, and by phone with award-winning filmmaker Andrea Kalin of Washington, D.C., about the upcoming film documenting the First Lady's life in Costa Rica. She was married to Jose' "Don Pepe" Figueres Ferrer, known as the Father of Democracy in Latin America.

-Broadcast on Sept. 13:

A discussion with guest Matt McDaniel, Columbus, GA, architectural historian, who has researched African Americans who left the Chattahoochee Valley after the Civil War, to start new lives in the West African Republic of Liberia. He talked about the similarities in the architecture of both places.

-Broadcast on Sept. 17:

A discussion with historian guest Eddie Ide about the Berlin Airlift of 1948-49, when American military pilots flew supplies and food into a Soviet-blockaded Berlin, to help save its citizens from starvation. The *Spirit of Freedom* Douglas C-54 aircraft will be flying to Montgomery, with its museum open for several days to the public. A Berlin Airlift veterans reunion also takes place at that time.

-Broadcast on Sept. 18:

A discussion with guest Elizabeth Britt about a pivotal event in Native American history – the 1811 address of Shawnee leader Tecumseh to the Creek National Council at Tuckabatchee, to galvanize Indian nations against white encroachment. The Talisi Historical Preservation Society and Friends of Tuckabatchee will present the outdoor drama, *Tecumseh at Tuckabatchee*, Oct. 5, with a Living History Village and Native American dancing.
