# Section 1. Issues.

The station has identified the following issues as significant to our radio community this quarter:

- Special Initiative: Troy Public Radio undertook a pilot campaign to implement the StoryCorps Great Thanksgiving Listen Oral History Project with the Phenix City, Alabama, School System. The project involved students interviewing their elders over the Thanksgiving holidays, after instruction and practice sessions at school. A report submitted by producer Wanda Norris can be found on pages 6 and 7 below.
  - A. Societal Issues: Preventing and Reversing Cognitive Decline; Bringing Creative Theater to Communities; A Retrospective on the 2010 Deepwater Horizon Oil Spill; Childhood Cancer; Wildlife Conservation; Montgomery Symphony Outreach; Alabama's Wild Turkey Population; Children's Artistic Creativity; Farming Opportunities for the Next Generation; Celtic Music Roots; Herbal Extracts from Garden Plants; Holiday Music from the Choir of Clare College, Cambridge; Alabama's Whitetail Deer vs. Reindeer- the differences.

Historical Issues: Alabama Bicentennial History; Alabama's Good Roads Movement, 1898 to 1928 (two interviews); Alabama Freed Slave and Bridge Builder Horace King; Old Cahawba, Alabama's First Permanent State Capital; Fort Toulouse Tricentennial and New Archaeological Finds (two interviews); EO9981: Escaping Jim Crow; Birmingham's Places of Historical Interest; Holiday Traditions in Early Alabama; the Music and Meaning of Holiday Observances.

# **Section II. Responsive Programs**

Programming broadcast on *In Focus* with host Carolyn Hutcheson covered each issue in a 9-minute time frame at 12:40 p.m. during the *Here and Now* news hour. Note: on Mondays and Fridays at 12:34 p.m., Don Dailey of Alabama Public Television's *Capitol Journal*, presented, with Carolyn's participation, a 4 ½ -minute recap of the week's political news, with the *NewsWrap* and the *Buzzword*.

#### A. Societal Issues:

#### - Broadcast on October 4:

A conversation by Skype with guest Dr. Dale Bredesen, MD, about reversing cognitive decline that leads to Alzheimer's. He is author of the book, "The End of Alzheimers, the First Program to Prevent and Reverse Cognitive Decline." The Alzheimer's Resource Center of Dothan will sponsor a Walk to Remember to raise Alzheimer's awareness on Oct. 7.

#### -Broadcast on October 10:

A conversation with guest Sarah Thornton, a graduate of the Alabama Shakespeare Festival's 2008 Master of Fine Arts Program, about the Bama Theatre Company she and other MFA graduates formed in New York, to bring their creative talents as actors and playwrights to new audiences across the U.S. Sarah is now the Artistic Director of the Cloverdale Playhouse in Montgomery, AL.

## -Broadcast on October 11:

A conversation with guest Chris Blankenship, new Commissioner of the Alabama Dept. of Conservation and Natural Resources, about the 2010 Deepwater Horizon Oil Spill, when he was a first responder as a Conservation officer. He came to help and stayed 60 days. Blankenship gave an update on the Alabama coastal environment since the spill.

#### -Broadcast on October 18:

A conversation by Skype with guest Dr. Corey Falcon, MD, about his research at UAB on childhood cancer, especially leukemia. He talked about promising new strategies using immunology.

#### -Broadcast on October 25:

A conversation with guest Marianne Hudson, Conservation Education Specialist with the Alabama Wildlife and Freshwater Fisheries Division of the Alabama Dept. of Conservation and Natural Resources, about spiders, scorpions, and other creepy crawlies for "Wildlife Wednesdays" on Troy Public Radio, since Halloween provides an opportunity to learn more about typical Alabama wildlife.

#### -Broadcast on November 8:

A conversation with guest Debbie Boutelier, former Extension Agent, Master Gardener, and Past-President of the Herb Society of America, about incorporating homegrown herbs into recipes, as well as making lavender, vanilla and mint extracts for unique flavorings and holiday gifts.

# -Broadcast on November 14:

A conversation with guests Thomas Hinds, Music Director and Conductor of the Montgomery Symphony, and its new Executive Director, Blake Thomas, about the symphony's role in the cultural life of the Capital city. With its additional emphasis on educational outreach, the symphony is bringing music instruction to the city's school students and offering them opportunities to hear and perform classical music.

## -Broadcast on November 15:

A conversation with guest Marianne Hudson, Conservation Education Specialist with the Alabama Dept. of Conservation and Natural Resources, about Alabama's wild turkey population. Hudson brought a live turkey to the studio and talked about its characteristics for the "Wildlife Wednesdays" program.

## -Broadcast on November 16:

A conversation with guests Shannon Morrell and her nine year-old son, Dominic Frontiero, River Region art student, about making his own holiday cards and writing accompanying stories. Morrell talked about the importance of having art opportunities for children and fostering hands-on creativity.

### -Broadcast on November 28:

A conversation with guest Jennifer Davidson, Russell County Coordinator for the Alabama Cooperative Extension Service and former Urban Horticulturist for the Georgia Extension System, about Farmer 101, the new ACES class to help people learn how to farm. She talked about farming basics for different kinds of property consumers have. The class opportunity has grown out of the widespread interest in organic foods.

#### -Broadcast on November 29:

A conversation by Skype with guest Chloe Agnew, Irish singer-songwriter and a founding member of the Celtic Woman vocal group, about Celtic music, its roots, and its worldwide popularity. She talked about the music's poignant lyrics and melodies and previewed her upcoming collaboration with the Atlanta Pops Orchestra for a MusicSouth concert in Dothan on December 12.

#### **Broadcast on November 30:**

A conversation by Skype with guest Graham Ross, acclaimed composer and Director of Music and Conductor of the Choir of Clare College, Cambridge, about the centuries-old holiday music that the choir performs. With some 40 recordings, the choir has preserved much of the music of the church, as well as championed music by contemporary composers. Ross briefly previewed the choir's December 9th performance at the Columbus RiverCenter.

# -Broadcast on December 13:

A conversation with guest Marianne Hudson, Conservation Education Specialist with the Alabama Dept. of Conservation and Natural Resources, for "Wildlife Wednesdays" about Alabama's whitetail deer and how they differ from reindeer. She brought antlers to the studio and also talked about current research on whitetails for healthy population management.

#### B. Historical Issues:

# -Broadcast on October 3:

A conversation with guest artist Laura Murray of Auburn about her Bicentennial project, "Amazing Alabama, a Coloring Book Journey Through Our 67 Counties." She explored the adult coloring book craze as she talked about several counties in our radio coverage area and their historical points of interest.

## -Broadcast on October 5 and November2:

Two conversations with guest Martin Olliff, Troy University Professor of History, about Alabama's roads in the early 20th century. His new book is "Getting Out of the Mud, the Alabama Good Roads Movement and Highway Administration, 1898 to 1928." The development of farm to town roads led to a nationwide system controlled and administered by the federal government. The second interview dealt with governmental politics and maneuvering by newspapers to establish a linked network of roads across the country, with catchy names to elicit citizen support and participation in road building projects.

# -Broadcast on October 24:

A conversation with guest Dr. Richard Bailey, historian and author of "They, Too, Call Alabama Home" and "Neither Carpetbaggers Nor Scalawags," books about African Americans after Reconstruction until the present. Dr. Bailey discussed tri-racial freed slave Horace King, who became an Alabama legislator, architect and engineer in the 1800s. King left his mark on the Alabama State Capitol building and the homes and bridges he built to connect the people of Alabama and Georgia.

#### -Broadcast on October 26:

A on-location conversation with guests Ned Jenkins, Fort Toulouse archaeologist, and commissioner Craig Sheldon, Alabama Historical Commission and archaeologist, about the latest archaeological finds at the 300 year-old site. They shared the news that the site actually contained several forts. Because of erosion from the adjacent Coosa River, successive forts were moved away from the banks. Fort Toulouse was the French outpost in the early 1700s, built to repel the British.

#### -Broadcast on November 1:

An on-location conversation at the Alabama Historical Commission's Fort Toulouse National Historic Landmark with guest historian Ove Jensen, Site Director, about the re-enactment of a pivotal meeting between French Colonial Marines and Alabama Indians 300 years ago. Fort Toulouse became the Southern frontier's inland outpost, established to ward off the British.

## -Broadcast onNovember 7:

A conversation with guest Dr. Felecia Bell, Director of the Troy University Rosa Parks Museum, about President Harry Truman's Executive Order 9981 and the museum's exhibit, EO9981: Escaping Jim Crow. She delved into the story of U.S. desegregation, with World War II setting the stage for President Truman's executive order, and the order's impact on Rosa Parks, who was a seamstress at Maxwell AFB.

### -Broadcast onNovember 9:

A conversation with guest Verna Gates, Birmingham native, about the places of interest and their history that are featured in her new book, "100 Things to Do in Birmingham Before You Die." Two historic theaters are featured prominently in the city's architecture and cultural scene.

## -Broadcast on December 5:

A conversation with guest Mary Ann Neeley, historian and author, about holiday traditions in 19th century Alabama. From holiday foods to decorations, the concept of celebrating Christmas evolved as the century progressed. Neeley and fellow historian Dr. Richard Bailey will conduct tours of the Cottage Hill historic neighborhood Dec. 10, and Old Alabama Town will present its Nineteenth Century Open House Dec. 12.

#### -Broadcast on December 14:

A conversation with guest Becky Taylor, retired Artistic Director of the Montgomery Chorale and Organist/Choir Director of Church of the Ascension in Montgomery, about the meaning of various Holiday observances - Advent, Nine Lessons and Carols, January Twelfth Night Celebration. Members of the arts community will take part in several of these observances at the church, to add an artistic element that illustrates the meaning of the presentation.

# Troy Public Radio/Phenix City Schools StoryCorps Report

The Phenix City Schools Initiative is a pilot campaign targeted to recruit and work with a school in our listening area to become aware of the opportunities available for students to become involved in the Great Thanksgiving Listen by StoryCorps. The mission for The Great Thanksgiving Listen is to preserve and share humanity's stories in order to build connections between people and create a more just and compassionate world. The role of Troy Public Radio was to offer

support for the teachers and students who would experience how the app works and then to use that information to highlight some of the stories from the students and to highlight the impact of the initiative to hopefully reach others in our listening area. The purpose of the pilot program was to see how well the school responded with resources and to find out what type of challenges they might face. We were able to communicate with the teacher in charge of the project and his support personnel assigned by the Superintendent so that we might offer the same opportunity to more schools in the future. Our objective was to make sure the tools available were adequate for participants to enjoy the experience of sharing their family histories. All interviews will become part of the StoryCorps Archive at the American Folklife Center at the Library of Congress. Over 100 stories from this initiative have been uploaded using #SharePCS to link them.

Troy Public Radio producer Wanda Norris, along with Intern Sarah Blain, made the 2-hour trip to the school to introduce the initiative to the Superintendent and his support panel on October 3.

On November 13, producers Wanda Norris, Joey Hudson, and Sarah Blain went back to conduct interviews to review the experiences of students that had already uploaded their stories so that we could develop features, and programming segments for "In Focus with Carolyn Hutcheson". It would also serve to get feedback for future school initiatives in our listening area. Programs we aired as a result of the accomplishment included promotional messages recorded by the staff at Troy Public Radio that included Kyle Gassiott, Carolyn Hutcheson, Ann Hart, Joey Hudson, Wanda Norris, (current student and part time employee), and Sarah Blain (current student and intern).
