

**FIRST QUARTER ISSUES PROGRAMS LIST FOR  
TROY UNIVERSITY PUBLIC RADIO**

**Section I. Issues.**

The station has identified the following issues as significant issues facing our community this quarter:

- A. Environmental Issues:** Alabama Tree Recovery Campaign in areas ravaged by the April 2011 tornadoes; Arbor Month plans by the Alabama Forestry Commission; Longleaf Pine Restoration; Fresh Air Family – the importance of families getting outdoors; Owls and the Ecosystem; Wintering Hummingbirds; the Wetumpka Marine Impact Crater; Alabama's Coastal Environment.
- B. Societal, Arts and Health Issues:** Teaching youngsters to dance; Asthma Awareness Month; Montgomery Area Council on Aging; Ethics in Business; Adult Obesity; School Readiness and Pre-K in Alabama; Investment Fraud; African-American DNA Research; Social Security; Oral History StoryCorps; Literacy Education; Bullying; Dealing Constructively with Anger; Employment for People with Disabilities; Community Support for Education; K-9 Police Dogs; Empty Bowls Project; Adult Fitness; the Impact of Rosa Parks' Life ; Adult Literacy; Multiple Sclerosis; Fiber Arts; Children's Diabetes Camp; Early Childhood Care and Education.
- C. Global Issues:** Current Events in the Middle East; the Alabama Goodwill Ambassador Program.
- D. Historical Issues:** Alabama's new Archaeological Museum; Alabama and Georgia's Southern Frontier History; the Montgomery Bus Boycott and Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr.; the new Museum of Alabama at the Alabama Department of Archives and History; the William Levi Dawson Institute at Tuskegee University; the Korean War; the Creek Indian Heritage Center.

**Section II: Responsive Programs.**

The station has broadcast programming dealing with each of the above-referenced issues. Programming on *Community Focus*, with host Carolyn Hutcheson, dealt with each issue in a 14-minute time frame, beginning at 12:10 PM Central time, each day.

## **A. Environmental Issues:**

**-Broadcast on January 3:**

A discussion with guests Matt McCullough, Alabama Forestry Commission Urban Forestry Coordinator, and Cliff Hawkins, Community Development Coordinator, with an update on the Alabama Tree Recovery Campaign, the AFC Tree Seedling Giveaway in February, and plans for Arbor Month.

**-Broadcast on January 24:**

A discussion with guest Traci Wood, Habitat and Species Coordinator for the Wildlife and Freshwater Fisheries Division of the Alabama Department of Conservation and Natural Resources, about the Longleaf Pine Restoration Grant program for landowners in most of the counties of our coverage area. Applications are being accepted for the 50/50 cost share on-site preparation, containerized longleaf pine trees, and planting on a minimum of 15 acres.

**-Broadcast on February 6:**

A discussion with guest Verna Gates, Founder and Executive Director of Fresh Air Family, which offers free and low-cost opportunities for children and their families to explore Alabama's outdoors. A wildflower expert and Board member of the Alabama Task Force on Obesity, she linked health and outdoor activity.

**-Broadcast on February 7:**

A discussion with guests Ken Naugher, Conservation and Enrichment Manager for the City of Montgomery Zoo, and Jennifer Hutcheson, Curator of Education, about owls and their role in the ecosystem. They brought Dusty the screech owl to the studio. They also talked about Animal Enrichment Day February 16<sup>th</sup> at the zoo, with the focus on activities that challenge the animals and enrich their experience in the zoo habitat.

**-Broadcast on February 8:**

A discussion with guest Fred Bassett, Federally licensed Master Bird Bander and Founder of the nonprofit Hummingbird Research, about his latest findings of wintering hummingbirds in our coverage area. To date, Fred has banded more winter hummers than in previous years. He is preparing to band hummers in Alaska this summer.

**-Broadcast on February 13:**

A pre-recorded discussion on location at the highest point of the Wetumpka Marine Impact Crater with guests Marilee Tankersley, Chair of the Wetumpka Impact Crater Commission, and Larry Johnston, Crater Commission member, about the environmental impact from a meteorite 85 million years ago. The five-mile-wide crater is the subject of study by scientists around the world. The guests shared the latest scientific findings and previewed the annual Crater Tours for the public.

-Broadcast on Feb. 18:

A seven-minute discussion with guest Mark Berte, Executive Director of the Alabama Coastal Foundation, about the organization's efforts to protect Alabama's coastal environment. Several "Connect to Your Coast" outreach gatherings are being held across the state, to familiarize citizens with the coastal ecosystem's challenges.

## **B. Societal and Health Issues:**

-Broadcast on January 2:

A pre-recorded discussion with guest Alexander Fost of Pasadena, CA, about his New Year's Resolution – to teach youngsters to dance by continuing to give free lessons. Alex was a finalist on the TV show, *So You Think You Can Dance*, and he talked about giving back, since he was mentored as a teenager without charge for dance lessons. Alex also shared several customs from his Mexican heritage.

-Broadcast on January 9:

A discussion with guests Melissa Dean, Aruna Rikhi, and Shaone Medlock, with the Alabama Asthma Program of the Alabama Department of Public Health, about the prevalence of asthma in Alabama and across the U.S. They also talked about asthma triggers, the Tools for Schools Program, the Air Quality Flag Program, and the No Idling Campaign, as well as the importance of flu shots for asthma patients.

-Broadcast on January 11:

A discussion with guest Donna Marietta, new Executive Director of the Montgomery Area Council on Aging, about the agency's services that meet the needs of Seniors in the five counties of the River Region.

-Broadcast on January 15:

A discussion with guests Alice Williams, Executive Director of Operations for the nonprofit Samaritan Counseling Center, and Peter Land, Board member and international leadership trainer and business consultant, about ethical practices in businesses and public service agencies. Nominations are being accepted for the River Region Ethics in Business and Public Service Awards.

-Broadcast on January 17:

A seven-minute discussion with guest Laurie Eldridge Auffant, Public Health Education Manager for the Alabama Department of Public Health, about today's kickoff of ScaleBack Alabama, the statewide program to help overweight adults. She talked about how Alabamians can use the ScaleBack website to develop their own weight-loss plan.

**-Broadcast on January 22:**

A discussion with guest Allison de la Torre, Executive Director of the Alabama School Readiness Alliance, about the Pre-K Task Force and its recommendations to extend Pre-Kindergarten into 120 new schools across the state, reaching 2000 additional four-year-olds. Pre-K programs are designed to ensure students' success in their educational careers.

**-Broadcast on February 4:**

A discussion with guest Dan Lord, Education and Public Affairs Director of the Alabama Securities Commission, about the basics of checking out potential investment and securities proposals. Ninety-seven percent of victims of investment crime fail to check out the person or entity offering the investment, for proper licensing with the ASC. The agency will do the research for free upon request.

**-Broadcast on February 5:**

A pre-recorded discussion by phone with guest Dr. Rick Kittles, Geneticist, Associate Professor at the University of Illinois at Chicago, and Nobel Prize nominee, about his research on African-American DNA. He has linked African tribal locales with African-Americans' DNA in the U.S. He will present a lecture on Feb. 9<sup>th</sup> at the Troy University Rosa Parks Museum about his research.

**-Broadcast on February 11:**

A 7-minute discussion with guest Kyle' McKinney, Public Affairs Specialist with the Social Security Administration, about the latest Social Security changes, including direct deposit of Social Security checks and the issuing of debit cards for those without checking accounts.

**-Broadcast on February 14:**

A discussion, pre-recorded by Kyle Gassiott by phone with guest Dave Isay, Founder and President of StoryCorps, which has collected and archived more than 45,000 interviews since 2003, in one of the largest oral history projects of its kind. The interviews are preserved at the American Folklife Center at the Library of Congress. Several Valentine love stories were featured in the broadcast.

**-Broadcast on February 15:**

A discussion with guest Katie Jackson, Board member of the Lee County Literacy Coalition, about the need for literacy education, and the impact that learning to read can have on people's lives. The East Alabama Literacy Alliance Kickoff will be held on Feb. 21<sup>st</sup>.

**-Broadcast on February 24:**

A discussion with guest Chris McCauley, Executive Director of the nonprofit David Mathews Center for Civic Life, about the current topic of Bullying for its Community Forums across Alabama. The Mathews Center will work with communities upon request to present forums.

**-Broadcast on February 25:**

A discussion with guest Laura Young, psychotherapist, about anger issues in today's society. She talked about how to channel the energy of anger into positive modes of behavior.

**-Broadcast on February 27:**

A discussion with guests Kristen Sherer, Goodwill Public Relations Director and Volunteer Coordinator, and Don Drenth, member of Goodwill Volunteer Services (GIVS), about the mission of Goodwill Industries to provide training and employment for people with disabilities. The guests previewed the GIVS Benefit for Goodwill Industries, to be held on March 19<sup>th</sup>.

**-Broadcast on March 1:**

A discussion by phone with guest Lavonda Gosselin, Program Director for Adopt-A-School Dothan, which has merged with Yes We Can! Dothan and the Dothan Education Foundation, to increase community support for public schools. Remarkable strides have been made in curtailing the dropout rate. A March 7<sup>th</sup> fundraiser will be held, featuring keynote speaker Leigh Ann Tuohy, the real-life Memphis mom of the movie, *The Blind Side*.

**-Broadcast on March 5:**

A pre-recorded on-location discussion with guest Lt. Wayne Barlow, outside the Prattville Police Department, about his K-9 partner, Officer Louie, a fifteen-year-old Labrador Retriever. On the eve of Officer Louie's retirement Feb. 5<sup>th</sup> at the Prattville City Council meeting, Lt. Barlow talked about the duties of K-9 police officers and their narcotics detection dogs. Officer Louie, trained to detect five different kinds of narcotics, assisted in numerous drug cases and participated in educational outreach programs at area schools during his long career.

**-Broadcast on March 7:**

A on-location pre-recorded discussion about the Empty Bowls Project that benefits the Montgomery Area Food Bank. Guests were potter Margaret Barber, Carolyn Strickland, and Marie Sanford, who talked about the process of creating bowls by hand, then decorating, painting, and firing them. Margaret demonstrated how to shape a bowl, using the potters wheel. Bowls made by numerous volunteers and students will be featured at the Empty Bowls event March 14<sup>th</sup>.

**-Broadcast on March 8:**

A discussion with guest Elie Lazar, renowned director, choreographer, ballet teacher and Assistant Professor of Dance at Troy University, about techniques to maintain health and fitness in adults. Body awareness, using balance and symmetry, is his guiding principle.

**-Broadcast on March 11:**

A discussion with guests Rosa Park, Korean teenager, her mother, and Georgette Norman, Director of the Troy University Rosa Parks Museum, about how young Rosa's parents were inspired to name their daughter after Civil Rights icon Rosa Parks. Rosa is a short-term volunteer at the museum and plans to use her experiences to teach her classmates about Rosa Parks' life work when she returns to school shortly in Korea.

**-Broadcast on March 13:**

A pre-recorded discussion at the Adult Literacy Center of the Central Alabama Laubach Literacy Council with guests Dr. John Harrell, President, and Woody Woodcock, Past President, about efforts to meet the needs of non-literate adults and those who read below an eighth grade level. Laubach Literacy training is based on phonics, one-on-one. The guests demonstrated a sample tutoring session.

**-Broadcast on March 14:**

A discussion with guest Craig Snell, Board member of the Alabama-Mississippi Chapter of the National Multiple Sclerosis Society and Co-leader of the MS Support Group in Montgomery, about the research being done at UAB to develop a new medication to treat MS, which afflicts more than 4000 Alabamians. He previewed the Fourth Annual MS Walk on March 16<sup>th</sup> in Montgomery.

**-Broadcast on March 18:**

A pre-recorded discussion on location at her Billingsley farm with guest Jen Lambert, about raising Shetland sheep and Angora goats and rabbits, for their fiber to use in fiber art. She previewed the Alabama Fiber Arts Festival March 22<sup>nd</sup> and 23<sup>rd</sup> in Montgomery.

**-Broadcast on March 20:**

A discussion with guests Durden Dean, Chairman of the River Region Lions Clubs Children's Diabetic Camp Committee, and Cindy Ducker, President of the Prattville Lions Club, about Camp Sugar Falls, a fun and educational free day camp for children with diabetes and their families, to be held April 27<sup>th</sup> at YMCA Camp Chandler in Wetumpka.

**-Broadcast on March 28:**

A discussion with guests Sophia Bracy Harris, Executive Director of the Federation of Child Care Workers of Alabama, and Georgette Norman, Director of the Troy University Rosa Parks Museum, about efforts to improve the early child care and education system in Alabama. The guests previewed an all-day conference, Raising the Curtain on Race, to be hosted by FOCAL on April 6<sup>th</sup> at the Troy University Montgomery Campus.

### **C. Global Issues:**

**-Broadcast on January 30:**

A discussion with guest Ambassador David J. Dunford, Troy University's Ambassador in Residence, a member of the U.S. Foreign Service for 29 years, serving posts in Oman, Saudi Arabia, Iraq, and Egypt. He discussed current events in the Middle East and implications for U.S. foreign policy.

**-Broadcast on March 22:**

A discussion with guests Leona Stemple and Debbie Gaddy about the Alabama Goodwill Ambassador Program, which hosts international guests attending the three training schools for U.S. and international military candidates at Maxwell Air Force Base. They talked about the volunteer opportunities for hosting international families.

### **D. Historical Issues:**

**-Broadcast on January 4:**

A discussion with guest Teresa Paglione, President of the Alabama Archaeological Society, about Alabama's new Archaeological Museum in Mobile. She gives an overview of the museum, which is hosting the annual meeting of the AAS Jan. 12<sup>th</sup>. Membership in the AAS is open to the public, and admission to the new museum is free.

**-Broadcast on January 8:**

A discussion with guest Mary Ann Neeley, historian and project director, about the Turning Points in Becoming Alabama Symposium at the Alabama Department of Archives and History, to be held on Jan. 12<sup>th</sup>. She talked about life on the Southern Frontier and how it shaped Alabama statehood.

**-Broadcast on January 10:**

A pre-recorded discussion with guests Rev. Robert and Jeannie Graetz, white activists during the Montgomery Bus Boycott. They recalled working with the young Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr., and the Montgomery Improvement Committee. Dr. King's mentors were disciples of Mohandas Gandhi, and they helped him develop his vision of the Beloved Community.

**-Broadcast on January 14:**

A discussion with guests Steve Murray, Director of the Alabama Department of Archives and History, and Debbie Pendleton, Assistant Director for Public Services, about plans for Phase II of the Museum of Alabama. They also previewed the monthly ArchiTreats lectures, funded in part by the Alabama Humanities Foundation.

**-Broadcast on February 1:**

A discussion with guests Lt. General Charles Cleveland (USAF Ret.) and Warren Trest, military historian and biographer of General Cleveland, about the general's unique experience of becoming a Fighter Ace fifty-six years after the Korean War. The guests talked about the circumstances of this short war.

**-Broadcast on February 20:**

A discussion with guest Dr. Wayne Barr, Director of Choral Activities at Tuskegee University, about the William Levi Dawson Institute, which honors the legacy of the famed African-American composer. Dr. Barr, also Director/Conductor of the Tuskegee Golden Voices Choir, previewed the Spirituals Concert, to be held on Feb. 24<sup>th</sup>.

**-Broadcast on February 26:**

A discussion with guest Mike Bunn, historian and Executive Director of the Historic Chattahoochee Commission, about the progress being made on the Creek Heritage Center and Trail, which will feature Creek Indian history in Alabama and Georgia. He talked about both states in the context of the Old Southwest and its Indian inhabitants and white settlers. Mike Bunn is co-author of *Battle for the Southern Frontier, The Creek War and the War of 1812*.

**-Broadcast on February 28:**

A pre-recorded on-location discussion about Alabama in the mid-1700s with guests at (French) Fort Toulouse National Historic Site, operated by the Alabama Historical Commission. Re-enactors Mike McCready, portraying Scots trader Lachlan McGillivray, Donna Spradley, and Ken Branson talked about Europeans who lived among and traded with the Creek Indians on the Southern Frontier.
