Several items of interest are attached to this formal report, all of which were covered either as a news item or as a public service matter.

KSGM local news is broadcast each weekday morning at 6am, 7am, 8am, 9am, 12pm, 3pm, 4pm, 5pm, 6pm and 7pm. A full time news director is employed to cover news in Chester, IL along with Ste. Genevieve and Perryville, MO.

KSGM public affairs announcements are done on both a recorded and live basis. Recorded features are put into a file to rotate on the air at varying times. Time is allotted weekday mornings at 6:40 and 7:40 for live public service announcements of community events. These announcements are also included in news hours at noon.

KSGM Focus interviews are recorded for airing in the noon news. These feature interviews with community members discussing items of importance.

KSGM news recognized many local school students attending the public and parochial schools in the community for their achievements in music, athletics and academics during the quarter, including those students recognized as students of the month as well as those award scholarships and other honors.

Achievements of area residents away at college were also detailed in a number of articles during the quarter.

The Chester, Ste. Genevieve and Perryville City Council and Randolph County Board of Commissioners meetings were covered in several news stories.

Activities of the Chester Unit School District #139, Perry County, MO District #32 and Ste. Genevieve County R-II's Board of Education were discussed in news stories.
