Accordingly, this letter is to advise you that KVRR; Fargo, North Dakota along with its satellite television stations KJRR; Jamestown, North Dakota, KBRR; Thief River Falls, Minnesota and KNRR; Pembina, North Dakota all assigned to the Fargo-Valley City, North Dakota DMA, elect the retransmission consent option, effective January 1, 2012.

We trust that we will be able to enter into a mutually acceptable arrangement that will provide for your continued carriage of KVRR and/or its satellites KJRR, KBRR, and KNRR after December 31, 2011.
