**Income tax proposal for education** (Aired 1/3/2017 @ 7pm for 1 minute, 30 seconds) - A group of business leaders want to force a vote on the people to raise taxes for education funding. The group says they'll gather signatures and force a vote of the people on a \$744-million-dollar state income tax increase for schools. House Republican leaders are wary about a big income tax increase, and hope to work out a compromise in the upcoming legislative session.

**WHS Undocumented Peers** (Aired 02/21/2017 @ 7pm, 2:30 minutes) – Students in the Salt Lake City school district swarmed a school board meeting tonight asking members to do more to protect immigrant students who are afraid of being deported. Since President Trump's crackdown on immigrants, teachers and kids say many students are living in fear. At this point nobody has any knowledge of immigration enforcement officials ever showing up at schools. But people are afraid right now and they want the school board to approve a plan to help students just in case immigration comes looking for them or their parents. This story explains what changes are being proposed, gives school board members a chance to react to the request and shows our viewers what immigrants are doing try keep their families and friends safe.
