INCLUDED:

***American Legion State Service Officer and Kenai Vet Center Readjustment Counselor ... available at the American Legion Post 16 in Homer, December 28th, to provide free assistance filing claims for disability and compensation and understanding Veterans Administration Benefits and Entitlements.

***American Red Cross encouraged residents to make donations to the Red Cross to help them continue to bring hope to families with nowhere else to turn by providing emergency shelter, hot meals, and financial support to families in need.

***AMSEA – Alaska Marine Safety Education Association conducting a free, fishing vessel drill conductor workshop in Homer and in Seward.
