Regularly Scheduled Programs

During the reported quarter, the station broadcast the following regularly scheduled programs that routinely address issues of importance to the station's community:

- Local Newscast "CBS News Philadelphia" at the following times, M-F/4:30-7am, 9-9:30am, 12-12:30pm, 4-6:30pm and 11-11:35pm with additional airings Saturday and Sunday mornings, evenings, and late night.
- CBS Mornings, CBS Saturday Morning, CBS Sunday Morning, CBS Evening News with Norah O'Donnell.
- 60 Minutes - Regularly scheduled one-hour weekly broadcast featuring in-depth interviews and reports of various lengths and topics. Sunday, 7 - 8 p.m.
- Face the Nation - Regularly scheduled one hour news broadcast featuring reports and interviews with government leaders, politicians, and international figures in the news. Sunday, 10:30 – 11:30 a.m.
- 48 Hours – Regularly scheduled news broadcast. Saturday, 10 - 11 p.m.
- "Health Watch" – features of varying lengths focusing on health-related issues, the latest in medical research and treatments, and other health related topics.
- "Money Watch" – features of varying lengths focusing on the latest in the economy along with tips and ways to save money.

Public Service Announcements – The station airs PSAs in rotation from various organizations that include topics such as Health, Stress, Pharmaceutical Safety, Childhood Cancer, and Veterans Services.

In addition, the station makes community responsive coverage available via CBSPhiladelphia.com, a 24/7 direct-to-consumer service that streams anchored news coverage and live breaking news events of interest to viewers in the local market.
