Obstruction Marking and Lighting Specifications for Antenna Structure

It is expressly understood that the issuance of these specifications is in no way to be considered as precluding additional or modified marking or lighting as may hereafter be required under the provisions of Section 303 (q) of the Communications Act of 1934, as amended.

Special Operating Conditions or Restrictions

The permittee/licensee in coordination with other users of the site must reduce power or cease operation as necessary to protect persons having access to the site, tower or antenna from radiofrequency electromagnetic fields in excess of FCC guidelines.

- The relative field strength of neither the measured horizontally nor vertically polarized radiation component shall exceed at any azimuth the value indicated on the composite radiation pattern authorized by construction permit BMPED-20100122ADA. A relative field strength of 1.0 on the composite radiation pattern herein authorized corresponds to the following effective radiated power: 2.80 kilowatts. Principal minima and their associated field strength limits: 90 degrees True: 1.85 kilowatts 340 degrees True: 0.52 kilowatts
- Pursuant to 47 CFR Sections 73.7002(c) and 73.7005(b) the permittee/licensee is required to construct and operate for a period of four years of on-air operations technical facilities substantially as proposed and shall not downgrade service to the area on which the preference was based.
- The licensee has demonstrated compliance with the FCC radiofrequency electromagnetic field exposure guidelines based upon the usage of the antenna specified herein. If the licensee makes any changes in facilities via modification of license application in accordance with 47 CFR section 73.1690(c), the subsequent Form 302-FM, application for license, must include a revised RF field showing to demonstrate continued compliance with the FCC guidelines.

Subject to the provisions of the Communications Act of 1934, subsequent acts and treaties, and all regulations heretofore or hereafter made by this Commission, and further subject to the conditions set forth in this license, the licensee is hereby authorized to use and operate the radio transmitting apparatus herein described.

This license is issued on the licensee's representation that the statements contained in licensee's application are true and that the undertakings therein contained so far as they are consistent herewith, will be carried out in good faith. The licensee shall, during the term of this license, render such broadcasting service as will serve the public interest, convenience, or necessity to the full extent of the privileges herein conferred.

This license shall not vest in the licensee any right to operate the station nor any right in the use of the frequency designated in the license beyond the term hereof, nor in any other manner than authorized herein. Neither the license nor the right granted hereunder shall be assigned or otherwise transferred in violation of the Communications Act of 1934. This license is subject to the right of use or control by the Government of the United States conferred by Section 606 of the Communications Act of 1934.
