## WZTV(TV) Second Quarter 2018 Children's Television Programming Report Explanatory Document

Because stations are no longer able to amend previously filed quarterly Children's Television Programming Reports, and consistent with the FCC's Form 303-S instructions, WZTV(TV) is providing information here that would have otherwise been provided in its Second Quarter 2018 Children's Television Programming Report.

In that report, the station inaccurately reported that the May 19, 2018 episodes of *Xploration Earth 2050* and *Xploration Nature Knows Best* were preempted and rescheduled due to sports coverage. The programs were in fact preempted for live coverage of the wedding of Prince Harry and Meghan Markle.

Additionally, the station inadvertently omitted preemption reports for the following programs, which were preempted for live coverage of World Cup soccer but which the station was unable to reschedule due to preexisting programming commitments during the "Core Programming" hours in effect at the time: three episodes of *Xploration Earth 2050*, two episodes of *Xploration Nature Knows Best*, two episodes of *Xploration Outer Space*, two episodes of *Xploration Awesome Planet*, one episode of *Xploration Weird But True*, one episode of *Xploration DIY SCI*, and three episodes of *Teen Kids News*.
