And that impacts roadways, infrastructure, etc. as well. The Army Corps of Engineers has been tasked with beach repair in Vilano Beach.

Trevor Gibbs reports on storm surge impacts on river levels inland, including \$34 million in damages from Irma in St. Johns Co. Reminder: flood waters are NOT clean, don't wade or swim through them.

Seg 3 – Buresh reports on storm names, and which names have been retired. He also reviews how storm damage is sometimes internal, sometimes external, and sometimes absolute. Things can be replaced, though. (Just keep insurance records.)
