7/2/2019 8:00pm

US threatens EU with \$4 billion worth of additional tariffs:

Just days after reaching a truce over trade with China, the US government on Monday increased pressure on Europe in a long-running dispute over aircraft subsidies.

7/8/2019 8:00pm

California hit by 7.1 earthquake:

A day after a major earthquake rattled Southern California, a strong quake has registered in the same area. The incident caused some building damage, minor injuries and multiple fires.

7/15/2019 8:00pm

US launches raids targeting migrant families:

US immigration authorities have launched a series of small-scale raids targeting undocumented families. But many municipal officials have refused to support the action, with New York's mayor calling it "unsuccessful."

Gunman opens fire at Gilroy garlic festival:

At least three people have reportedly been killed in a shooting at a major food festival in California. Police say the suspected gunman has been shot dead.

Russia and the US nuke 32-year-old INF treaty:

The US is out of the Intermediate-Range Nuclear Forces missile treaty with Russia, Secretary of State Mike Pompeo says. The US immediately announced plans to start testing a new missile.

Here's why Silicon Valley is in California:

The future is being invented in California, not in Germany. An entrepreneur and a VC who work in both places say the reasons for this are deep-rooted and will be very difficult to overcome — but things are improving.

US markets sink, sparking fears of recession:

Stock markets in the United States have dropped sharply after the Treasury yield curve temporarily inverted for the first time in 12 years. The news signals growing investor fears of a recession.

Fridays For Future in the US: A small but determined movement:

Climate activist Greta Thunberg has arrived in the US, where her Fridays for Future movement hasn't taken off yet. But the teens who did show up to recent protests have made their position clear: They won't back down.

San Francisco declares NRA 'domestic terrorist organization':

An "epidemic of gun violence" has prompted San Francisco Council to officially label the National Rifle Association a "terrorist organization." The move sparked a war of words with weapons advocates.

9/11/2019 8:00pm

US moves to ban flavored e-cigarettes amid spike in youth vaping:

The Trump administration will ban flavored e-cigarettes. It comes in response to a surge in youth vaping and health concerns following a handful of mysterious deaths and hundreds of lung illnesses linked to the product.

US President Donald Trump has called them the "highest sanctions ever imposed on a country." The announcement was made in a wide-ranging press conference with Australian PM Scott Morrison.

The revelation by The Wall Street Journal was related to a whistleblower complaint about Trump. The US president said it was "dumb" to think he would say something inappropriate in phone calls with foreign leaders.
