## EEO INITIATIVES TAKEN IN PERIOD August 1, 2012 - July 31, 2013

The following initiatives have been undertaken by WNCW pursuant to Sections 73.2080(c):

- 1. (v.) WNCW has had an Internship program for Isothermal Community College's Broadcast Technology students (as well as other students) in place since 2001. Up to three students are accepted into the program each semester. Work schedules are usually ten hour per week. Interns can help with the set-up and engineering of performances, write on-air scripts, perform production work, assist with music playlist and chart production or prepare weather forecasts. Other duties are assigned as needed by the station and according to each student's aptitude and interests. Intern activity reports are reviewed and forwarded to the student's instructors as needed. An end-of semester evaluation is prepared and forwarded to the student's instructor. The internship program has been expanded and encourages participation by students and other interested individuals not necessarily enrolled at Isothermal Community College.
- 2. (v.) WNCW has had a Business and Development Internship program for Isothermal Community College's Broadcast Technology students (as well as other outside students) since 2012. At current time, one student is accepted into the program each semester or year. Work schedules are designed around the number of hours required by the class instructor. Interns can assist in clerical duties, data entry, fund raising events, marketing opportunities, underwriting sales, web site maintenance, billing and traffic needs. Other duties are assigned as needed by the station and according to each student's aptitude and interests. Intern activity reports are reviewed and forwarded to the student's instructors as needed. An end-of semester evaluation is prepared and forwarded to the student's instructor.
- 3. (viii) All WNCW employees attend twice-yearly Isothermal Community College Professional Development Day and Convocation including 3 full days of Professional Development Workshops.
- 4. (xiv) WNCW's Business Operations and Development Director as well as the Director of Program Operations and Engineering attended monthly Leadership Training provided by Isothermal Community College designed to develop and fine tune leadership and management skills including workshop training by Human Resources and Attorneys concerning hiring practices and methods of ensuring equal employment opportunity and preventing discrimination
- 5. (viii) An Employee Education Fund was established allowing \$1500 per Fiscal Year to be awarded to a station employee seeking further education and acquire skills that could qualify them for a higher-level position.
- 6. (xi) (xvi) A Career Exploration Camp hosted by Isothermal Community College and Sponsored/Participation by various WNCW staff and

- management in efforts to inform and educate school age children on career opportunities in broadcasting in both the areas of programming, business and development.
- 7. (xi) (xvi) WNCW's Music Director participated in a Career Day at a Middle School with the purpose of informing students of career opportunities in broadcasting.
