Nor is it designed to list every program broadcast by the Station that is responsive to the selected issues.

The station went off the air on September 7, 2017, due to widespread power outages following Hurricane Irma, and was further damaged by Hurricane Maria, which struck Puerto Rico on September 20. As of January 8, 2018, the station has not returned to the air.

COMMUNITY AFFAIRS

El Pan De La Palabra (Bread of Life)

Produced by the Office of Media and Communications of the diocese of Ponce and moderated by the Bishop of Ponce, this program consists of community and religious leaders moderating discussions about how to solve community problems, with a focus on practical solutions that can be understood and implemented by viewers.

Dog Tales

The show also features a recommended reading list about dogs and promotes writing and artistic skills by encouraging viewers to participate in contests.
