For quarter beginning: July 1, 2023

WALV-CD programmed the “MeTV Network” on its main channel (46.1). MeTV programs classic television series and classic movies. A simulcast of 13 Sunrise runs M-F 4-5a and a simulcast of 13 Sunrise Weekend runs Sa-Su 6-7a on WALV-CD (46.1) throughout the entire quarter. The remaining sub-channels of WALV-CD, broadcast as follows: Twist (46.2), Shop LC (46.3), Heroes & Icons (46.6). Twist is an entertainment network focused primarily on reality and lifestyle programming, Shop LC is an on-line shopping channel, and Heroes & Icons, focuses on action/adventure, westerns, crime dramas, sci-fi and superhero shows.

Attached are descriptions of issue-responsive programming broadcast by this station during the reporting period. The listed programs aired on the station during the reporting period on the days and times indicated. Each program regularly provides information or addresses current local issues of concern to viewers in the area where the station is located.
