Internship Program

WHNT continues with its efforts to teach children about our weather initiatives by hosting a monthly "Sketch the Sky" program where children are encouraged to send in Weather drawings that are highlighted during our Newscasts every day. Monthly there is a gathering at SciQuest where all the winners learn about being a meteorologist and learn about the science behind forecasting the weather. There are also interactive computer games that focus on educating children about the weather. Our Meteorologist staff shows the guests the art of working the green wall and chat about weather in general.

WHNT Television has an internship program with Calhoun Community College, The University of Alabama in Huntsville, The University of Alabama, Auburn University, The University of North Alabama and Jacksonville State. All journalism, communication, and marketing majors can intern in the news room, Creative Services department and Sales and marketing department to develop hands-on skills for today's working environment. Students work the number of hours required for credit by the school...usually 15 hours per credit hour. Other departments offer job shadowing which allows the student to watch and participate in daily activities and conclude if that is something they wish to pursue. Our Fall 2012/2013 program brought us two students wanting a news experience. The Spring/Summer 2013 brought two students looking for experience in Sports, Weather, News.

Scholarships

WHNT has partnered with Athens State University for a scholarship program to be used in the education of Journalism.

Employee Training

WHNT Television tries to encourage employees to continue learning and sharing their knowledge with others. WHNT Assistant News Director finished up his year long training with the Leadership of Huntsville Program and our General Sales Manager kicked off her year in the Leadership of Huntsville program which is a yearlong venue of learning where the needs of the community are. Our Meteorologist team continue to increase their knowledge attending 2 weather conferences during the year. Our Sales Team took advantage of a Jim Doyle Conference, along with hosting a Marketing Event for Clients and Leaders of the community to see more about Marketing and Social Media also attended the NAB Small Market Exchange. WHNT completed 16 Webinar's on different aspects of Clients, Internet, etc and we were involved in Wide Orbit training along with a GSM Conference and Linkedln 101 for Business for all of our Account Executives, we also do a Face Book 101 Business Class teaching the participants effective ways to promote their business through Face Book. Creative Service Team was involved in Brutus training in March 2013, Staff Training of Best Practices and Lynda.com was used by our Creative Producers to learn new techniques and our Creative ServiceDirector was able to attend the ABA Conference training, while our Interactive Producer went through the Social Media - SoMET13US in November of this year. There is constant cross training going on between employees learning other job skills. We had our Department Heads all attended the ABA convention and went to a variety of the workshops. News training consisted of "Saturday for our Success" Workshops – a 5 hour internal training focusing on writing, producing, storytelling, shooting etc, Brutus Staff Training, Facebook 101 training for our staff. We attended the FBI Citizens Academy where a reporter went thru 9 weeks of working with the FBI. Talent Couching for WHNT anchors, Connect Class 16 where our Assignment Desk staff participated in a Leadership of Huntsville program, a session on Marketing at the Governor's Conference on Tourism and Corp training from another Stations News Director on key points of our on air. WHNT also had a Producer Boot Camp, and attended the John O'Leary Leadership Seminar.

Career Fairs

WHNT Television attended 5 career fairs this year. We attended career fairs at University of Alabama, Athens State Job Fair, WBCNA/SSV Enpowering Veterans Job Fair, University of Alabama Huntsville, Oakwood College along with 3 Virtual job fairs put on by Alabama Broadcasters. These fairs are a great way to recruit future employees and to help young adults follow the right paths to work in an environment such as ours. We spoke with over 50 or more students with an interest in the facets of Television.
