# **Internship Program**

In September of this year news managers and a member of the meteorology team hosted a dozen broadcasting students from the University of North Alabama in Florence. We talked with the group about what to expect when they get into the real world of broadcast/multimedia news, how we approach stories and ethics of journalism. Assistant News Director, David Williams, encouraged all of them to take part in TV news internships and told them how to go about applying for one at WHNT NEWS 19.

WHNT hosted a professor visiting our station to shadow all aspects of 21<sup>st</sup> century newsgathering and information distribution. The teacher was originally from Zambia and is an Assistant Professor of Mass Communications at Emory & Henry College in Southwest Virginia. She was given the opportunity through a NATPE Faculty Development Grant. The program gives college and university media educators the chance to gain firsthand professional experience to take back to the classroom.

WHNT Television has an internship program with Calhoun Community College, The University of Alabama in Huntsville, The University of Alabama, Auburn University, The University of North Alabama and Jacksonville State. All journalism, communication, and marketing majors can intern in the news room, Creative Services department and Sales and marketing department to develop hands-on skills for today's working environment. Students work the number of hours required for credit by the school...usually 15 hours per credit hour. Other departments offer job shadowing which allows the student to watch and participate in daily activities and conclude if that is something they wish to pursue.

#### **Scholarships**

WHNT has partnered with Athens State University for a scholarship program to be used in the education of Journalism.

## **Employee Training**

WHNT Television tries to encourage employees to continue learning and sharing their knowledge with others. Some employees have had training associated with the new high definition equipment that is currently being installed in the station. They have been taught new means in Directing Newscasts, moving to a tapeless newsroom involving news gathering and editing. Some others went to photo-shop classes where they learned more innovative ways to display our news.

### Career Fairs

WHNT Television attended 1 career fairs this year. Athens State University spotlighted us at their events. These fairs are a great way to recruit future employees and to help young adults follow the right paths to work in an environment such as ours. We spoke with 50 students with an interest in the facets of Television and were able to obtain 25 resumes for us to use in future job opportunities.
