

Tours are given to groups and organizations that want to see how a television station works. The tours are primarily offered to school groups and youth organizations. Each tour is conducted by a member of the WASV-TV staff and lasts for an hour or more. Questions can be asked at all points on the tour. The tour gives history of broadcasting as well as WASV-TV. Included are all aspects of the broadcasting facility and the types of jobs offered in each area.

318 people toured WASV-TV during this quarter. They represented 19 different groups. Most of these were career exploration classes or clubs.

WASV-TV certifies that all children's television programs carried during this quarter, which are identified below, were formatted so that, as a matter of standard policy and practice, the programs would not exceed the following commercial time limits in Section 73.670 of the FCC's rules:

Weekends: 10:30 minutes in any hour program and 5:15 in any half-hour program.
