Re: Election of Retransmission Consent

Dear Jeremy:

This letter is in response to your letter dated March 17, 2016 notifying us that Google Fiber, Inc. ("Operator") intends to begin providing cable service in the Los Angeles DMA. KTTV and KCOP-TV, Los Angeles, CA ("Stations"), licensed to Fox Television Stations, LLC ("FTS"), elect retransmission consent with respect to retransmission of their broadcast signals by Operator. This election is for any and all communities serving the Los Angeles DMA.

Accordingly, Station hereby notify Operator that, pursuant to Section 325(b)(3)(B) of the Communications Act of 1934, as amended (the "Act"), and Section 76.64(f)(2) of the Rules and Regulations of the Federal Communications Commission (the "Rules"), Station elects to assert its rights under Section 325(b)(1)(A) of the Act and Section 76.64(a) of the Rules to require that Operator obtain Station's express consent before retransmitting its signal. This election of retransmission consent is for the remainder of the current election cycle, ending December 31, 2017.
