Dear Ms. Dortch:

On behalf of AMFM Radio Licenses, L.L.C. (the "Licensee"), the licensee of WASH(FM), Washington, DC (the "Station"), and pursuant to Section 73.1510 of the Commission's Rules, this letter requests an extension of experimental authority to continue operating the Station with Secondary Audio and Advanced Application Services in order to determine the viability of these services and to determine the optimal data bandwidths for various program material and data services, including, in particular, the testing of data bandwidths of 48 Kbps for the main and auxiliary channels. The Licensee intends to coordinate the experimental operations of these stations with electronics manufacturers in order to develop these Advanced Application Services.

Experimental authority for the Station is requested to cover a six-month experimental period. A written synopsis of the test findings will be submitted to the Commission following the conclusion of the experimental period. The Licensee acknowledges that during such experimental period: (a) the authorized power of the Station may not be exceeded, (b) emissions outside the authorized bandwidth must be attenuated to the degree required for the particular type of station, and (c) the minimum required schedule of programming for the class and type of station must continue to be met by the Station.


