To serve the public interest, the station broadcasts programming responsive to issues of concern to the CSRA and its listening public. The following lists issues most significant to our programming and the treatment of them:

Issues of importance this quarter included the following during the months of April, May, and June. In the month of April 2015, we welcomed several guests on our show. In the beginning of April, there was a guest appearance from Lauren Enloe of Georgia Regents University. Mrs. Enloe addressed medical issues involving the head, neck, and the importance of maintaining our health, as well as the upcoming World Voice Day. We were also visited by Jill Brown who touched on the topic of golf. Annie Blair appeared on our show to discuss Restoration, the way that God restores our life after a traumatic event. Then, we were visited by Ann. N. Johnson, from the Jessye Norman School of Arts (JNSA), who covered the mission and activities of JNSA and an upcoming fund-raising fashion show that they would be sponsoring. To close out April, we welcomed guests such as Taifa Butler, of the Georgia Budget and Policy Institute. Ms. Butler discussed the mission of the Institute and the benefits of the newly passed Georgia Transportation Bill. Other discussions included upcoming events of the community and safety tips to follow when being stopped by a law enforcement officer, as listed in the Metro Courier, to avoid any type of confrontation. In the month of May 2015, we welcomed various guests who spoke on an array of topics. Gaylord Jenkins, of the Jessye Norman School of Arts, discussed her 30-year modeling career and elaborated on the fund-raising fashion show that she is coordinating for the Jessye Norman School of Arts. Next, we welcomed Lavern Gold, of the United Way of the CSRA (U/W), who discussed the United Way's current Community Needs Assessment. The Community Needs Assessment will enable organizations to apply for partnership with the United Way organization. There was also a guest appearance from Dr. Judy Scheel, who spoke on eating disorders and how they can affect a family as a whole. She also expatiated on matters related to eating disorders. Finally, we were visited by Joel Cruz who discussed music and his work with mentoring

youth. Additionally, topics such as how to help children grow up experiencing happiness, safe-driving tips provided by the Georgia's DriverAlert Arrive Alive program, and upcoming community events were also addressed. June was filled with outstanding guest appearances and very exciting discussions. We opened June with tips on dealing with loneliness as highlighted in the Metro Courier and a discussion of leadership with Dr. Kevin Leman. We were also visited by Dr. Lyndsey Hornbuckle who discoursed the importance of exercise for women and Lauren Meccia, a jazz vocalist and saxophonist, who promoted her new CD. There were also guest appearances from Dr. Enchuategui, Dr. Richard Land, Dr. Maryrose Gerardi, and Evelyn Polk. Dr. Enchuategui spoke on common challenges that are faced by Latino and African Americans, as well as solutions to those challenges. Dr. Land discussed ethics and automobiles, while Dr. Gerardi discussed Post-traumatic Stress Disorder. The foundations and building upon of family was conveyed by Evelyn Polk. Other topics that were highlighted in the month of June included tips on how to keep kids' brains stimulated during the summer as conveyed in an article by Georgia Regents University, tips on making retirement productive as listed in the Metro Courier, and upcoming summer events to help beat the heat. We closed out June with an array of visitors. Trish Dialva came by to discuss being motivated as a general topic, while Shuane Arnold spoke about being motivated to excel. Reverend Daughtry's opinion on local history's ties to the present and Dr. Kenneth Doka's opinions on justice were very thought-provoking. Dr. Nikki Giovanni talked to us about poetry and writing, as well as Ms. Nancy Johnson, who came by to tell us about her new CD. Also in the month of June, we had a guest Dr. L. Diane Bennett who discussed "Living intentionally. Finally, we were visited by Kate Dunaway who discussed solutions and prevention of chronic diseases and Dr. Kevin Leman, who gave his excellent standpoint on healthy families and leadership.
