To serve the public interest, the station broadcasts programming responsive to issues of concern to the CSRA and its listening public. The following lists issues most significant to our programming and the treatment of them:

Issues of importance this quarter included the following during the months of July, August, and September. In the month of July 2020, we welcomed several guests. Steve Luxenberg appeared on the show to discuss America's journey from slavery to segregation. The community note highlighted Perry Publishing and Broadcasting Company (PPBC) and Velvet Perry's honor as President-elect of the Georgia Association of Broadcasters, exercise tips from the American College of Sports Medicine (ACSM), and Georgia Budget and Policy Institute (GBPI) push for revenue increases in the coming year. Susan Berfield appeared on the show to discuss the struggle: will unfettered capitalism or a just economic system prevail? Crystal Smith joined the show to talk about being inspired to live well.
