PROGRAM: **CAMPAIGN WATCH** 7 NEWS CW AT 10PM
DATES: JULY 4, 2016

PROGRAM SUMMARY: NORTH CAROLINA IS THE FOCUS OF THE PRESIDENTIAL RACE. THE PRESUMPTIVE REPUBLICAN NOMINEE, DONALD TRUMP, WILL BE IN RALEIGH TUESDAY NIGHT SPEAKING AT THE DUKE ENERGY CENTER FOR PERFORMING ARTS. NORTH CAROLINA IS CONSIDERED TO BE A SWING STATE IN THIS ELECTION. PRESIDENT BARACK OBAMA WON THE TARHEEL STATE IN 2008, BUT IN 2012, MITT ROMNEY DID. PRESIDENT OBAMA WILL ALSO BE IN NORTH CAROLINA ON TUESDAY. HE WILL APPEAR WITH THE PRESUMPTIVE DEMOCRATIC NOMINEE, HILLARY CLINTON. OBAMA AND CLINTON WILL BE AT THE CHARLOTTE CONVENTION CENTER.

PROGRAM SUMMARY: THE LAW THAT REMOVED THE CONFEDERATE BATTLE FLAG FROM THE SOUTH CAROLINA STATEHOUSE LAST YEAR, INCLUDED PUTTING THAT FLAG ON DISPLAY AT THE "CONFEDERATE RELIC ROOM AND MILITARY MUSEUM. BUT ONE YEAR LATER, IT IS STILL NOT ON DISPLAY. STATE LAWMAKERS HAVE NOT APPROVED ANY MONEY FOR IT. THE PRICE TAG IS \$3.6 MILLION. \$550,000 OF THAT WOULD BE FOR THE CONFEDERATE FLAG. THE REST WOULD BE FOR DISPLAYING ITEMS IN STORAGE NOW.

PROGRAM SUMMARY: THE GOP NATIONAL CONVENTION STARTS TODAY, AND ON THURSDAY NIGHT, DONALD TRUMP WILL GIVE HIS SPEECH AS REPUBLICAN NOMINEE FOR PRESIDENT. A LARGE CONTINGENCY FOR VIRGINIA, UTAH AND COLORADO WANT TO ROLL CALL VOTE ON THE FLOOR TO CHANGE THE RULES AND UNBIND THE DELEGATES WHO ARE BOUND FOR TRUMP. THIS AFTERNOON THE PARTY ADOPTED POSITIONS ON LGBT LIFESTYLES.

IT IS A SIX POINT BOUNCE FROM LAST WEEK'S REPUBLICAN NATION CONVENTION AND THE BEST SHOWING FOR TRUMP SINCE LAST SEPTEMBER.

FOR NOW, TRUMP IS REFUSING TO ENDORSE HOUSE SPEAKER PAUL RYAN OR ARIZONA SENATOR JOHN MCCAIN IN THEIR PRIMARY ELECTIONS. RYAN'S CAMPAIGN SAID IT NEVER ASKED FOR TRUMP'S ENDORSEMENT.

PROGRAM SUMMARY: GOVERNOR NIKKI HALEY SAYS SHE IS GOING TO CONTINUE TO SUPPORT REPUBLICAN NOMINEE DONALD TRUMP. THAT IS ACCORDING TO THE STATE NEWSPAPER. HALEY MADE HER CONFIRMATION DURING A NEWS CONFERENCE AND SAYS OF THE TWO CANDIDATES, TRUMP IS THE BEST CHOICE. MANY OTHER REPUBLICANS ARE NOT AS SUPPORTIVE OF TRUMP. FIFTY FORMER NATIONAL SECURITY OFFICIALS, WHO SERVED REPUBLICAN PRESIDENTS, FROM NIXON TO GEORGE W. BUSH, SIGNED A LETTER TO THE AMERICAN PEOPLE ANNOUNCING THEIR REFUSAL TO VOTE FOR DONALD TRUMP. THEY CALLED A TRUMP PRESIDENCY A "RISK TO OUR COUNTRY'S NATIONAL SECURITY AND WELL-BEING."

PROGRAM SUMMARY: THERE HAS BEEN A SETBACK FOR PRESIDENT BARACK OBAMA'S ORDER ON SCHOOL BATHROOMS AND TRANSGENDER STUDENTS. A FEDERAL JUDGE HAS BLOCKED IT RULING IN FAVOR OF 13 STATES WHO OPPOSED THE ORDER. IN MAY THE GOVERNMENT TOLD PUBLIC SCHOOLS TRANSGENDER STUDENTS MUST BE ALLOWED TO USE BATHROOMS CONSISTENT WITH THEIR CHOSEN GENDER IDENTITY. JUST DAYS AGO THE JUSTICE DEPARTMENT SUED NORTH CAROLINA OVER THE SO-CALLED "BATHROOM LAW" THERE. THE PRESIDENTS OF SEVEN EVANGELICAL CHRISTIAN COLLEGES IN SOUTH CAROLINA ARE ASKING GOVERNOR NIKKI HALEY TO STAND UP FOR THEM. IN A LETTER, SCHOOL LEADERS FROM BOB JONES, ERSKINE, NORTH GREENVILLE AND ANDERSON UNIVERSITIES, ALONG WITH OTHERS ASKED HALEY TO USE HER PLATFORM TO "PROMOTE RELIGIOUS FREEDOM."

CLINTON HAS TRIED TO PAINT TRUMP AS HOSTILE TOWARD MINORITIES WHILE DEALING WITH CRITICISM OVER A SO-CALLED "PAY-TO-PLAY" OPERATION BETWEEN THE CLINTON FOUNDATION AND THE STATE DEPARTMENT.

GOVERNOR NIKKI HALEY SAID, "A WORLD WAR TWO FIGHTER PILOT AND PRISONER OF WAR WHO BECAME A FIGHTER FOR GREENWOOD COUNTY IN THE STATE SENATE, JOHN DRUMMOND WAS BORN TO SERVE AND HE LIVED AN EXTRAORDINARY LIFE."

YOU CAN STILL APPLY IN PERSON BY MAIL OR FAX TO YOUR LOCAL DSS OFFICE. ALSO, IF YOU APPLIED FOR SNAP BENEFITS DURING JUNE, YOU SHOULD RE-SUBMIT YOUR FORMS TO YOUR LOCAL OFFICE.

PROGRAM SUMMARY: ONE OF THE LATEST FOOD RECALLS COULD IMPACT YOUR FAMILY'S BREAKFAST. CONTINENTAL MILLS IS RECALLING ITS "KRUSTEAZ BLUEBERRY PANCAKE MIX" FOR POSSIBLE E.COLI CONTAMINATION. COMPANY OFFICIALS SAY IT AFFECTS BOXES MADE BETWEEN APRIL AND JUNE. SO FAR, NO INJURIES HAVE BEEN REPORTED. THE COMPANY SAYS CALL ITS CONSUMER RELATIONS TEAM FOR A FULL REFUND.

A TRACKING SERVICE CALLED "FLIGHT STATS" SAYS MORE THAN 500 FLIGHTS HAD BEEN SCRUBBED AND NEARLY 1,200 DELAYED BY THIS AFTERNOON. DELTA OFFICIALS SAY SOME COMPUTER SYSTEMS ARE STILL WORKING SLOWLY MORE THAN A DAY AFTER A POWER OUTAGE LED TO MORE THAN 1,500 CANCELED FLIGHTS. DELTA BLAMES THE OUTAGE ON EQUIPMENT PROBLEMS AT GEORGIA POWER.

THIS ALL COMES AFTER A PIPELINE STARTED LEAKING IN ALABAMA. THE COMPANY WHICH OPERATES THE PIPELINE SAYS IT EXPECTS TO COMPLETE REPAIRS BY THE END OF THIS WEEK.

ACCORDING TO OUR COVERAGE PARTNERS AT THE INDEPENDENT MAIL, FORCIBLE SEX OFFENSES AND DATING VIOLENCE JUMPED FROM TWO CASES IN 2012, TO 17 IN 2014. ADVOCATES SAY IT IS PROOF MORE VICTIMS WANT TO COME FORWARD.
