Louise Registering Students for Coming Year

Bring child's social security card, certified birth certificate, up-to-date immunization record and proof of residency. If registering a child for Pre-K, proof of income is required. Pre-K is open to all Louise ISD residents, but they must provide all documentation listed above even if you don't qualify. Students turning 5 on or before September 1st, are eligible for the Kindergarten program. Students who turn 4 on or before September 1st, and who meet state criteria are eligible for the Pre-K program.
