1	Internship Program (Spring – January 2020 – May 2020)	Our SEU has an on-going internship program that provides college students with a unique opportunity to acquire a general working knowledge of radio station and multi-media operations.
		*Internship operations were abruptly suspended March 16, 2020 due to COVID-19 outbreak and City of Austin Stay at Home Orders. Spring semester 2020, we hosted three (3) student interns from St. Michael's Prep Academy, Texas State University, and University of Texas. All interns were in-studio and thus were unable to continue the sessions through April and May
2	Participate in event/program for or on behalf of an educational institution relating to careers in broadcasting	On April 7, 2020, our SEU's Marketing/Promotions Director participated in our first Virtual Career Expo hosted by University of Texas at Tyler. We actively recruited for future marketing/promotion internships. The challenges of adapting to a virtual setting were clear, but we were able to speak to a captive audience of journalism/broadcast students. We continue to correspond with two students looking at internship opportunities in the coming semesters.

3	Internship Program (Summer – May 2020 – August 2020)	During the summer semester 2020, our SEU hosted two (2) student interns from University of Georgia, and University of Tennessee. These interns were our first test for a virtual curriculum. Because many of our internship opportunities involved learning hands-on studio work, we shifted our focus to a higher concentration on our digital platforms and pulled them under the Marketing/Promotions umbrella. These interns were exposed to the digital platforms, the importance of staying engaged with audiences in stressful/trying times, community support campaigns, and the relationship between sales and programming. Typical tasks included: assisting with the development of social media strategy and messaging, basic graphic design, website content/blog creation, copywriting.
4	Internship Call Out – Advertised via Handshake and through Student Advisors	On July 1, 2020 our SEU Marketing Director hosted 5 students via zoom for an Internship Information Session. The students were exposed to the different internship opportunities our organization offers. Because we had students from freshman to senior classes, we covered the COVID adjustments we made and discussed hopeful future opportunities once we are able to again host guests in our studio for instruction.
5	Spring Mentorship Orientation – Student Advisors Westlake High School	On December 9, 2020 our SEU Marketing Director hosted 4 students via zoom for a Student Mentorship Information Session arranged with the high school student advisor. The students were exposed to the different career mentorship opportunities available. We discussed how our Mentorships work for High School students with COVID accommodations and how we hope to host in-person week-long mentorship opportunities when the public health threat is over. From this group, we were able to secure a Spring Virtual/Mentorship program for a senior high school student.

6	Internship Program (Spring – January 2021 – May 2021)	During the spring semester 2021, our SEU hosted two (2) student interns from Texas State University and Westlake High School. Because of COVID-19 protocols, these internships were carried out virtually and were focused on content creation and digital marketing. Our interns were exposed to all of Austin Radio Network digital platforms, understanding the importance of staying engaged with audiences in "a new normal", supporting community lead campaigns, and the relationship between sales, clients, and programming. Typical tasks included: assisting with the development of social media strategy and messaging, basic graphic design, website content/blog creation, copywriting, and research.
