Pastor Franklin Graham joins Eric Metaxas to speak about the efforts that his Samaritan's Purse field hospital put forth to set up camp in New York City at the height of the coronavirus. He spoke about the hospital being a God sent idea.

"For him to open up Central Park for us, right across the street from Mt. Sinai and partner with Mt. Sinai, they've been a tremendous organization for us to partner with, to me it's just kind of a God thing," Graham tells Eric. "So many New Yorkers have been so supportive. People have brought food, people have come by to say thank you. We've had that kind of outpouring of just gratitude and thanks from people all across the city."

Graham also addressed people from the LGBT community who were in an uproar that he had positioned himself in the city because of the pastor's view about marriage being strictly between a man and a woman.

"If they disagree, that's fine they can have their views but we're in the middle of a fight right now to save lives," he says. "This really isn't the time."

The life of a woman prisoner is very dangerous. Many of these women will never adapt to so-called 'normal life' because of the traumatic experience they face behind those prison walls. There's a tremendous amount of tension, violence, and fear that women face daily. The percentage of women going to prison has skyrocketed over the last 30 years by 646%, rising from about 15,000 women to over 110,000 women. So many of these women experience physical and sexual abuse while imprisoned. More than one million women are a part of the criminal justice system whether it is through incarceration, probation, or parole. Many of these women are mothers, or mothers to be, at the time of their imprisonment, and 62% of these women have children under the age of 18 while in prison. These incarcerated women find themselves in a place of regret, depression, physical harm, and sometimes with suicidal thoughts. But the bars of a prison cell are not strong enough to hold back God's grace, love and forgiveness. These are the stories of a few women who were once locked in a prison cell but found the keys to freedom through Jesus Christ.
