Enfoque focused on several pressing issues that the state of Colorado is facing, and important details about the upcoming elections are discussed. The immigration crisis: Denver has received a record number of migrants, and it has become harder for the city to meet the needs. Some migrants have been moving to the mountain areas where there are even less resources. Spokesperson of Denver Health shared they are running out of money to provide health services to migrants. Two representatives from Denver Public Schools shared what the school district is doing to provide resources to migrant families and the efforts they are making to ensure that migrant children, living in shelters, can make it to school.

Primary election key dates in the state were shared as well as information for viewers on what their options are and key dates to ensure they make their voices heard. Political analyst Jesús Sánchez helped explain the Colorado ruling that removed Donald Trump from the ballot and what to expect moving forward as the case was now being heard by the United States Supreme Court. A young Latino leader was also interviewed, who gave some insights on the grass roots efforts to push out the vote. The program also mentioned elections in Mexico and what eligible voters living in the United States should do to vote in Mexico. The show concluded with FAFSA delays and updates.
