

PROGRAM TYPE & EXPLANATION OF REGULARLY SCHEDULED PROGRAMS

Good Day Philadelphia/ News -- Weekdays, 5am - 9am. This live program, produced by WTXF-TV, covers areas of national, regional, and local interests and routinely features in-depth treatment of local issues, including live guests and remote broadcasts throughout the program.

FOX 29 News at Noon / News – Weekdays, 12 – 12:30pm. In addition to coverage of fast-breaking news stories, this program routinely features in-depth, 1- to 2-minute treatment of local issues, produced by WTXF-TV.

FOX 29 News at Five / News -- Weekdays, 5-6pm. In addition to coverage of fast-breaking news stories, this program routinely features in-depth, 1- to 2-minute treatment of local issues, produced by WTXF-TV.

FOX 29 News at Six / News – Saturdays and Sunday, 5-6pm. In addition to coverage of fast-breaking news stories, this program routinely features in-depth, 1- to 2-minute treatment of local issues, produced by WTXF-TV.

FOX 29 News at Ten / News -- Daily, 10pm to 11pm. In addition to coverage of fast-breaking news stories, this program routinely features in-depth, 1- to 2-minute treatment of local issues, produced by WTXF-TV.

The Last Word / News – Weekdays, 11 – 11:30pm. This daily, half-hour news program hosted by Kerri-Lee Halkett and Bruce Gordon focuses on issues relating to politics and the election races for local, state and national offices. The show will air weeknights through the November 4th election. (October 1 – November 7)

Summary of Major Issues Treated During the Quarter:

Business/Economy/Consumer – FOX 29 Consumer Reporter Michelle Williams teams up with “Consumer Reports” to offer viewers regular in-depth segments on products and services which include how-to’s, reviews, and where to get the best deals for your money. She also does regular consumer product reviews in “Deal Or Dud.”

Crime – In an effort to help Philadelphia combat its ongoing murder problem, FOX 29 reporter Dave Schratwieser regularly reports on “FOX Unsolved,” a series which tells the story of a person who has been murdered and their case is unsolved. The series is designed to garner leads and tips for police from viewers who might have information to help solve the crime. In addition, Dave Schratwieser began a series of new reports called “Serve and Protect,” which focus on stories about local police who have gone beyond the call of duty to “Serve and Protect” citizens.

Government – In this busy election season, FOX 29 reports regularly on both local, state and national candidates and the issues that effect the election. Stories educate viewers on candidates’ positions on the issues and offer commentary on how that will affect local viewers.

Health & Medical – FOX 29 Medical Reporter Dr. Mike Cirigliano report the latest medical news in “Health Talk.” This quarter FOX 29 kicks off its Alzheimer’s Association Memory Walk Campaign which focuses on the issue of Alzheimer’s and dementia. The Alzheimers’s Association of the Delaware Valley is our partner in the campaign, which features regular reports on the programs and services of the Alzheimer’s Association and stories to motivate viewers to participate in one of the upcoming Memory Walks. The campaign continues through November and culminates with the Annual Philadelphia Memory Walk at Citizens Bank Park.
