

Summary of Major Issues Treated During the Quarter:

Business/Economy/Consumer – FOX 29 Consumer Reporter Michelle Williams teams up with “Consumer Reports” to offer viewers regular in-depth segments on products and services which include how-to’s, reviews, and where to get the best deals for your money. She also does regular consumer product reviews in “Deal Or Dud” and “Real Deal.” A new series called “Sign of the Times” talks about common things occurring in the current economic state.

Crime – In an effort to help Philadelphia combat its ongoing murder problem, FOX 29 reporter Dave Schratwieser regularly reports on “FOX Unsolved,” a series which tells the story of a person who has been murdered and their case is unsolved. The series is designed to garner leads and tips for police from viewers who might have information to help solve the crime.
