

COMMUNITY APPEARANCES:

Due to the Corona Virus pandemic, many scheduled community appearances were postponed, canceled, or changed from LIVE, in-person appearances to virtual appearances.

Wednesday, January 13th – Bill Anderson hosted the Greater Philadelphia Chamber of Commerce Economic Outlook conference for 1000 business people and Chamber members. This event was virtual and held over Zoom.

Wednesday, January 13th – Chris O’Connell hosted the J.P. Morgan Chase Accessibility zoom lunch discussion with the Epilepsy Foundation of Eastern PA. There were 80 participants from around the country.

Tuesday, February 9th – Dennis Bianchi was a guest speaker for a Temple University course titled “The Business of Media.” He spoke via Zoom on the topic of local TV station management.

Monday, March 8th – Kristen Rodgers was a virtual panelist in the Philadelphia Union “Voices: Insights and Experiences from Women in Sports Reporting,” event, held in honor of Women’s History Month and International Women’s Day. The goal was to celebrate and recognize the lives, work, and achievements of Women in Sports, past and present in Philadelphia, and discuss the paths each took to discover their respective passions within the sports industry, the experiences that shaped their career development, and some of the mentors that helped lead the way for them.

March 17th – 20th – Donnell Jackson participated as a mentor in the National Association of Black Journalists Multimedia Short Course, which helps student members gain knowledge and skills necessary to tell news stories on various content platforms. The seminar gives students hands-on experience and access to mentors who currently work at some of the top media outlets in the country. Thursday, March 18th – Kristen Rodgers hosted the Philadelphia 76ers second annual “Virtual Girls Summit,” featuring members of the WNBA. Targeted to female youth, the conversation centered around the importance of sports participation, life lessons sports can teach, best ways to stay active and connected during this time at home and more. The event was recorded live via Zoom and broadcast live across 76ers social media channels and its website.
