On June 18, 2008, Blue Mountain Broadcasting Association's K36EW, Channel 36, College Place, WA, filed an application with the Federal Communications Commission, FCC Form 301-CA, as a minor modification to allow the licensed facility to move the station eastward 1 km and for a flash cut to digital transmission.

K36EW's maximum effective radiated power (ERP) is 0.226 kW and transmitter output power is 0.02 kW.

A copy of this application is available for public inspection during our regular business hours at 715 SE 12th Street, College Place, WA 99324. Individuals who wish to advise the FCC of facts relating to the station's application for moving and for digital flash cut should file comments and petitions with the FCC prior to Commission action on this application.

On July 11, 2008, Blue Mountain Broadcasting Association's K22BI, Channel 22, Walla Walla, WA, filed an application to the Federal Communications Commission, FCC Form 301-CA, for digital displacement from channel 22 to channel 21 and for a flash cut to digital transmission.

This is a minor modification of an existing licensed facility to change to channel 21 to avoid interference from a co-channel 22 station in Spokane, WA.

The new maximum effective radiated power (ERP) will be 1.36 kW and transmitter output power will be 0.25 kW.
