The text of those announcements follow:

On May 4, 2015, K36EW-D, K21JQ-D, and K31KL-D were granted licenses by the Federal Communications Commission to serve the public interest as a public trustee until February 1, 2023. Our licenses will expire on February 1, 2023. We filed an application for license renewal of each station with the FCC on September 26, 2022. Copies of these applications are available for inspection at www.fcc.gov (<http://www.fcc.gov>). They contain information concerning the stations' performance over the last 8 years.

Individuals who wish to advise the FCC of facts relating to our renewal application, and to whether this station has operated in the public interest, should file comments and petitions with the FCC by January 2, 2023.
