ISSUES COVERED: Hong Kong New Policy, One Station, Two Systems

PROGRAM: “Rush Hour”

LENGTH: 60 minutes

DATE/TIME AIRED: 1/4 @6:00pm

GUEST/S AND PROGRAM DESCRIPTION: China’s top legislature has given the green light for establishing a one-stop checkpoint for those traveling between the Chinese mainland and Hong Kong. A New Year’s Day pro-democracy march by thousands of demonstrators ended in scuffles and a defiant stand-off with police at the newly reopened “Civic Square” protest site outside Hong Kong’s government headquarters.
