ISSUES COVERED: Taiwan School 'Nazi rally' Impact and Consequences

PROGRAM: “Rush Hour”

LENGTH: 60 minutes

DATE/TIME AIRED: 1/3 @6:00pm

GUEST/S AND PROGRAM DESCRIPTION: A high school parade in Taiwan in which students dressed as Nazi soldiers and carried swastika banners has created a storm of criticism in one of Asia’s most open societies. According to this news, the program guests were two different political view’s commentaries. Mr. Bin Lee believed the school teacher was the main person to responsible for this whole thing and shouldn’t blame the students. Mr. Chi Dai claimed the government in Taiwan was weak and no guts to defend outside criticism.

ISSUE/S COVERED: To be Sanctuary State in California?

The program interviewed Dr. Steve Chan who addressed the KMT must be united, tolerant and diversified and that he intends to reinvigorate its ideals, which he said created Asia's first democratic nation and made Taiwan a beacon of democracy for Chinese communities around the world.
