ISSUES COVERED: California Senate Passes 'Sanctuary State' Bill

PROGRAM: “Rush Hour”

LENGTH: 60 minutes

DATE/TIME AIRED: 4/5 @6:00pm

GUEST/S AND PROGRAM DESCRIPTION: After heated debate, the California Senate passed a so-called “sanctuary state” bill. While many Republicans argued that the bill would lead to dangerous criminals being let loose on the streets but Democrats said that California had to take a stand in defense of “hardworking” immigrants. The program guest was Sing Tao Newspaper Mr. Darrel Chang who was senior reporter and weighted in this Sanctuary bill’s future and conflicted with President Tump’s policy.
