ISSUES COVERED: Brett Kavanaugh Confirmed to Supreme Court

PROGRAM: "Rush Hour"

LENGTH: 60 minutes

DATE/TIME AIRED: 10/9 @6:00pm

GUEST/S AND PROGRAM DESCRIPTION: The Senate voted 50-48 to confirm Kavanaugh to the highest court in the land but the controversial issue didn't stop.
