ISSUES COVERED: Las Vegas Massacre

PROGRAM: “Rush Hour”

LENGTH: 60 minutes

DATE/TIME AIRED: 10/2 @6:00pm

GUEST/S AND PROGRAM DESCRIPTION: A gunman opened fire on a crowd of concertgoers at the Route 91 Harvest music festival on the Las Vegas Strip in Nevada, leaving 58 people dead and 546 injured. The suspect was 64-year-old Stephen Paddock who fired hundreds of rifle rounds from his suite on the 32nd floor of the nearby Mandalay Bay hotel. His motive is unknown.
