WUSQ-FM Quarterly Issues/Programs List

WUSQ-FM provides its listeners with programming and public service announcements that address issues of concern to our local community. Among the issues determined to be of most concern to the community during the preceding calendar quarter were:

- Awareness: President Georgia Rossiter came to our studios to explain what SVERN is, and shine light on what they do as a young non-profit that rescues horses and mules from situations of neglect and abuse. We were surprised to discover how many animals they are helping, and how much bigger the need is, beyond what they can handle. Dr. Diane Schnoor spoke to our listeners to make them aware of the special summer enrichment programs they are creating for local children, including for special needs children, and how the programs are being received.
- Child Safety: Ex Dir Kelly Bober sat with us as we tearfully discovered how children suffering sexual abuse are identified, and the layers of treatment they receive from the Child Safe Center.
- Community Health: Dr. Lauren Cummings from the Substance Abuse Coalition spoke to our listeners in detail about how our community has responded to the opioid crises, specifically how several local agencies, law enforcement, and Valley Health have come together to combat this crisis as a group, and where we need to focus next.
- Disaster Relief: Captain Kelley Durant discussed the Salvation Army's centennial of service in Winchester, marking events where the agency has been there for the community over the past 100 years.
- Emergency Assistance: Our chapter of te American Red Cross has to be prepared to respond to a multitude of possible disasters, and Executive Director Leslie Cavilla explained how they stay prepared, and how our listeners can best help themselves in the event of an emergency.
- First Responders: A special program produced by iHeart Radio to remember those lost by serving and doing acts of good on 9/11.
- Homelessness: Executive Director Brandon Thomas discusses his highly publicized motorcycle tour to bring awareness to the plight of the homeless here in the Valley, sharing personal stories of how his life has changed after working with homeless men and women here.
- Literacy: Executive Director Mark Seaford explains the broad variety of programs it directs to help people in need of becoming more literate in our valley. The agency is helps adults with reading proficiency, but also gets them up to speed with computer skills, and teaches English as a second language to local immigrants. It also provides help with citizenship classes.

• Suicide Prevention: Our community is lucky to have a 24-hour crisis hotline, and Executive Driector Rusty Holland informed our listeners of the widening range and growing number of calls that Concern Hotline is taking now.
