#### WUSQ-FM Quarterly Issues/Programs List

WUSQ-FM provides its listeners with programming and public service announcements that address issues of concern to our local community. Among the issues determined to be of most concern to the community during the preceding calendar quarter were:

- Awareness: Executive Director Shannon Ott brought board president Georgia Rossiter to our studio to discuss what SVERN is. We were surprised to discover the need for an organization to bring aid to unwanted/abused horses in our valley. They opened our eyes to the extent of the need, what their needs are as a non-profit, and how they care for the horses. The Shenandoah Valley Discovery Museum has an extensive summer program that makes STEM-learning fun for kids, with a Harry Potter theme local children are loving. Assistant Director Dr Diane Schnoor told us all about that and their new sensory program for special needs children in our valley.
- **Disaster Relief**: Captain Kelley Durant discussed the Salvation Army's centennial of service in Winchester, marking events where the agency has been there for the community over the past 100 years.
- Early Childhood Education: Executive Director Heather Foreman came to our studios to share with us the ways her agency Kids Club of the Northern Shenandoah Valley provides accessible care for our least fortunate families, while providing early childhood tutoring to better prepare them to succeed in school.
- Emergency Assistance: VAN is the Valley Assistance Network, and Jennifer Hall, the Director of Community Engagement came in to tell our listeners about the broad reach of this resource that connects people in need to agencies who provide assistance. The Red Cross seems to always be asking for blood . . . we break down why the need for blood has increased. Also what that one pint of donated blood can do. Community Engagement officer, Leslie Caliva, also shared what our local Red Cross' needs are in 2019, as their volunteer staff shrank in 2018. She also discussed how we can all be more prepared for natural disasters.
- Fundraising: Kristen Glaise, the Executive Director of Historic Belle Grove Plantation visited with us to discuss how their biggest fundraiser of the year would fund the archeological work being done to discover more about the enslaved populations of the northern Shenandoah Valley, providing information on a people we have little history of. The Red Cross seems to always be asking for blood . . . we break down why the need for blood has increased. Also what that one pint of donated blood can do. Community Engagement officer, Leslie Caliva, also

shared what our local Red Cross' needs are in 2019, as their volunteer staff shrank in 2018. She also discussed how we can all be more prepared for natural disasters.

- Homelessness: Our area just had it's Homeless census/person count. The number of homeless has increased dramatically. Brandon Thompson, the Executive Director of Winchester Rescue Mission visited with us to inform our listeners about causes of Homelessness, what they can do to help, and how they can volunteer at the Mission.
- Mentoring: Mark Seaford from Literacy Volunteers spent time in our studios explaining how his organization has broadened "literacy" to being computer literate to be able to access employment; English literacy for ESL classes and more.
