- **Awareness:** Agencies wished to highlight their activities, progress, and purpose in the community.
  - **Child Development:** Helping children build essential skills and competencies and be able to feel safe, cared for, valued, and useful in their family and community.
  - **Children's Health:** As good as our local hospitals are, Children's Miracle Network funds Children's National, our area hospital, devoted exclusively to healing children with advanced medical problems.
  - **Drug Recovery:** Examining how local agencies, healthcare providers, and local law enforcement are combining efforts to prevent and treat drug abuse in the Valley.
  - **Healthcare:** Organization explains the enhanced need for blood right now and the need to be aware of your own health.
  - **Healthy Living:** Aids Response Effort explains how Aids is a chronic disease that is not a death sentence and that the organization is committed to helping local clients live long, full, healthy lives.
  - **Mentoring:** Big Brothers Big Sisters has a great need for volunteer mentors.
  - **Senior Care:** With a growing aging population in our area, there is a great need to understand what's involved in end of life planning for estates and health care.
  - **Volunteering:** The impact on our community of local Universities requiring student's volunteer hours.
