During the August 9 meeting, the Board of Education voted to implement the COVID protocol for the 2021-2022 school year. The protocol specifies several important points including the use of face masks. The use of a face mask for students and staff is highly recommended regardless of their vaccination status. This means that you can decide whether or not you want your children to use this important safety measure while they are at school. There are two reasons why I believe that some parents and community members are stirring, the first is because this condition only applies to students and school personnel, to all parents, volunteers, and community members. Those who visit any of our facilities IF they must use their face mask on a mandatory basis for the duration of their visit. The second reason is because due to a federation order, ALL students who use the school or city bus to attend school must wear the mask during their journey.
