Dear Licensee:

On March 30, 2010, the Video Division, Media Bureau (“Division”) issued a Forfeiture Order finding that KATV, LLC (“KATV”), licensee of Station KATV(TV), Little Rock, Arkansas, liable for its willful and repeated violation of Section 73.670 of the Commission’s Rules for failure to comply with the limits on commercial matter in children’s programming.¹ This letter is to inform you that the Division does not plan to take further action relating to this matter and considers this proceeding closed. You should not construe the closing of the proceeding as a determination that the violation did not occur. The Division will not hesitate to take action against the Licensee for violations, including those of a similar nature, that occur in the future.
